12	Sections 16-50-20, 16-50-26, and 16-50-28, Code of Alabama
13	1975; to increase the membership of the board of trustees by
14	three at-large members; to decrease term lengths from 12 to 6
15	years; to limit members to two six-year terms; to create and
16	provide for the operation of a nominating committee; to
17	provide a procedure for holding emergency meetings of the
18	board; to allow members of the board to participate in
19	meetings by electronic means; and to provide further for the
20	compensation of members.
21	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
22	Section 1. Sections 16-50-20, 16-50-26, and 16-50-28
23	of the Code of Alabama 1975, are amended to read as follows:
24	"\$16-50-20.
25	"(a) There is hereby created a Board of Trustees for
26	Alabama State University, the state educational institution at
27	Montgomery, Alabama. The board of trustees shall consist of

1 two members from the congressional district in which the 2 institution is located and one member from each of the other congressional districts in the state as constituted on October 3 4 6, 1975, and who shall reside in that district, four members from the state at large who shall reside in different 5 6 districts, three at-large members who may be selected from 7 outside the state, and the Governor, who shall be ex officio president of the board. Except for a trustee at large, the 8 position of any trustee shall be vacated at such time as he or 9 10 she shall cease to reside in the district from which he or she was appointed. The trustees shall be appointed by the 11 12 Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate, in 13 such manner that the membership shall consist of at least a 14 majority who are alumni and who have received a bachelor's 15 degree from the said university; at least one-half of the board shall be from the prevailing minority population of the 16 17 state according to the last or any succeeding federal census. Trustees shall hold office for staggered terms of three, six, 18 19 nine and 12 years with an equal number appointed to like 20 terms, such period of terms designated by the appointing 21 authority, with one-fourth to expire every three years, or 22 until their successors are appointed. The three at large 23 members who may be selected from outside the state shall be 24 appointed in 2015 for initial terms of four years, five years, 25 and six years, respectively, and for terms of six years 26 thereafter. Commencing on the effective date of the act 27 amending this subsection, members shall be appointed for terms

1 of six years. All appointments shall be effective until 2 adversely acted upon by the Senate. Provided, however, no trustee who is currently serving on the board or whose term 3 4 has just expired, who has been previously confirmed by the Senate, shall be required to be reconfirmed for the new term 5 under this section, once appointed by the Governor. A6 7 Commencing on the effective date of the act amending this subsection, no member may be appointed to serve a second term 8 of 12 years, but and no member shall be appointed to serve as 9 10 trustee for more than a total of 12 years or two six-year terms. The first members, however, shall be eligible to serve 11 for two full additional terms in addition to their initial 12 13 terms. No trustee shall receive any pay or emolument other 14 than his or her actual expenses incurred in the discharge of 15 his or her duties as such. No member of the governing board or 16 employee or student of any public postsecondary education 17 institution, no elected or appointed official having the power of review of the Alabama State University budget, other than 18 19 the Governor and no employee of the State of Alabama shall be eligible to serve on the board. No member shall serve past 20 21 September 30 following his or her seventieth birthday.

"(b) No trustee who is serving on the said board on April 30, 1986, shall lose his or her seat because of this section; provided, however, the Governor may re-designate the period of the term of these members so as to conform to the provisions of subsection (a).

1	" <u>(c)(1)</u> Commencing on the effective date of the act			
2	adding this subdivision, each trustee shall be appointed by			
3	the Governor from a list of three persons nominated by a			
4	nominating committee. The nominating committee shall consist			
5	of the following members:			
6	"a. One member of the board as elected by the			
7	membership of the board.			
8	"b. One member of the faculty senate as selected			
9	jointly by the faculty senate and the staff senate and			
10	certified to the committee by the president of the faculty			
11	senate and the president of the staff senate.			
12	"c. The president of the student government			
13	association.			
14	"d. One member of the Montgomery County Senate			
15	Legislative Delegation, as selected by the delegation.			
16	"e. One member of the Montgomery County House of			
17	Representatives Legislative Delegation, as selected by the			
18	delegation.			
19	"f. The president of the national alumni			
20	association, or his or her designee.			
21	"g. A community representative as selected by the			
22	membership of the nominating committee.			
23	"(2) Where applicable, members of the nominating			
24	committee shall serve at the pleasure of the appointing			
25	authority for a period of at least one year.			
26	"(3) Thirty days before the expiration of the term			
27	of a board member, or within 20 days following the creation of			

1	a vacancy in a term of office by death, resignation, or other
2	cause, the president pro tempore of the board shall call a
3	meeting of the nominating committee, giving at least 10 days'
4	notice. The nominating committee, by majority vote of those
5	present at the meeting, shall nominate to the Governor the
6	names of three individuals who are qualified pursuant to
7	subsection (a) to fill the respective position on the board.
8	The Governor shall appoint one of the nominated persons to the
9	board by and with the advice and consent of the Senate. If the
10	appointment is made by the Governor while the Legislature is
11	not in session, the name of the appointee of the Governor
12	shall be submitted to the Senate not later than the third
13	legislative day following the reconvening of the Legislature.
14	If the appointment is made by the Governor while the
15	Legislature is in session, the name of the appointee shall be
16	submitted to the Senate not later than the next legislative
17	day following the date of the appointment.
18	"(4)a. If the vacancy on the board is caused by the
19	expiration of the term of a trustee who has served for less
20	than the maximum 12 years of service on the board, the
21	vacating trustee shall continue to serve on the board until
22	his or her successor is confirmed by the Senate. If the
23	holdover trustee is reappointed to the board, the term of
24	office for which he or she is reappointed shall be effective
25	retroactive to the date of the expiration of the previous
26	term. If a new trustee is appointed pursuant to this
27	paragraph, the term of office for which he or she is appointed

shall be effective retroactive to the date of the expiration
 of the previous term.

3	"b. If the vacancy on the board is caused by death,			
4	resignation, or the expiration of the term of a trustee who			
5	has served for the maximum 12 years of service on the board,			
6	the position on the board shall remain vacant until the name			
7	of an appointee is submitted by the Governor to the Senate. If			
8	the appointee is not confirmed or rejected by the Senate			
9	during the session in which his or her name is submitted, the			
10	appointee shall nevertheless continue to serve in the position			
11	on the board until the next session of the Legislature, during			
12	which his or her name shall be resubmitted for confirmation.			
13	If an appointee is confirmed by the Senate, the term of office			
14	for which he or she is appointed pursuant to this paragraph			
15	shall be effective retroactive to the date the vacancy was			
16	created on the board, for the remainder of the unexpired term			
17	if the vacancy was created by death or resignation, or for the			
18	entire term if the vacancy was created by the expiration of			
19	the previous term. If an appointee is rejected by the Senate,			
20	the position on the board shall remain vacant as the			
21	nominating and appointing procedure provided in this			
22	subsection begins anew and until an appointment is made and			
23	confirmed by the Senate. If a trustee is appointed to fill an			
24	unexpired term of less than three years, the time shall not be			
25	counted toward the maximum 12 years of service.			
26	" <u>(5) If the nominating committee fails to submit a</u>			
27	list of nominees to the Governor within 30 days after a			

1 vacancy occurs due to expiration of term, death, resignation,
2 or any other cause, the Governor, by and with the advice and
3 consent of the Senate, may appoint an otherwise qualified
4 trustee to the board, notwithstanding the absence of such
5 nominations.

6 "(d) The board shall provide for the conduct of
7 annual training sessions for trustees regarding the fiduciary
8 responsibility of a trustee to the university and any other
9 topic deemed appropriate by the board.

"§16-50-26.

"The first meeting of the Board of Trustees of 11 12 Alabama State University after all members have been appointed 13 shall be upon the call of the Governor. The board shall hold 14 regular meetings on the first Thursdays in May and November at 15 the university unless the board shall, in regular session, shall determine to hold its meetings at some other time and 16 17 place. The regular May meeting shall be the regular annual meeting. Special meetings of the board may be assembled by 18 either one of the two methods outlined as follows: 19

"(1) Special meetings of the board may be called by the Governor. In calling such special meetings the Governor shall mail a written notice to each trustee, naming the time and place thereof, at least 10 days in advance of the date of such meetings.

"(2) Upon the application in writing of any four
members of the board, the Governor shall call a special
meeting, naming the time and place thereof and causing notices

to be issued in writing to the several members of the board.
 Such meetings shall not be held on a date less than 10 days
 subsequent to the notices from the Governor.

4 "(3) An emergency meeting of the board may be called when circumstances exist that are deemed by the Governor, by 5 the president pro tempore of the board, or by three members of 6 7 the board to present a risk to personal health, safety, or property or to the operation of the university. The three 8 board members shall communicate their request for an emergency 9 10 meeting to the Governor or to the president pro tempore of the 11 board by the most expedient means available to them. Notice of 12 an emergency meeting shall be given at least 72 hours before 13 the time the emergency meeting is to commence unless the 14 circumstances of the emergency require the meeting to convene 15 sooner.

"(4) Members of the board may participate in a 16 17 meeting of the board or any committee of the board by means of telephone conference, video conference, or similar 18 communications equipment by means of which all persons 19 participating in the meeting may hear each other at the same 20 time. Participation by such means shall constitute presence in 21 22 person at a meeting for all purposes. However, a majority of a quorum of the members of the board, or, in the event of a 23 24 meeting of only the executive committee, a majority of a 25 quorum of the executive committee of the board shall be 26 physically present at the location noticed and called for the 27 meeting in order to conduct any business or deliberation.

1 Members of the board and any committees of the board may not 2 utilize electronic communications except as in compliance with the Alabama Open Meetings Act. Except for emergency meetings, 3 4 notice of board meetings shall be provided in accordance with the Alabama Open Meetings Act and telephone or video 5 conference or similar communications equipment shall also 6 7 allow members of the public the opportunity to simultaneously listen to or observe such meetings. 8 "§16-50-28. 9

10 "The certificate of the president of the board or, 11 in his <u>or her</u> absence, of the president pro tempore, 12 countersigned by the secretary, shall entitle the several 13 trustees to the payment of their actual expenses incurred in 14 the discharge of their duties as trustees <del>in conformity with</del> 15 <del>regulations governing travel expenses of state officials</del>."

16 Section 2. This act shall become effective 17 immediately following its passage and approval by the 18 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
