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- 9 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 5-73-122(a)(3), concerning the possession
- of a handgun in a publicly owned building or facility or on the State Capitol
- 11 grounds, is amended to read as follows:
- 12 (3) However, this subsection does not apply to a person carrying
- or possessing a firearm or other deadly weapon in a publicly owned building
- 14 or facility or on the State Capitol grounds:
- 15 (A) For the purpose of participating in a shooting match

- 18 (B) If necessary to participate in a trade show, exhibit,

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           (a) As used in this section:

                 (1)(A) "Public university, public college, or community college"
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1	means an institution that.
2	(i) Regularly receives budgetary support from the
3	state government;
4	(ii) Is part of the University of Arkansas or
5	Arkansas State University systems; or
6	(iii) Is required to report to the Arkansas Higher
7	Education Coordinating Board.
8	(B) "Public university, public college, or community
9	college" does not include a private university or private college solely
10	because:
11	(i) Students attending the private university or
12	private college receive state-supported scholarships; or
13	(ii) The private university or private college
14	voluntarily reports to the Arkansas Higher Education Coordinating Board; and
15	(2) "Staff member" means a person who is not enrolled as a full-
16	time student at the university, college, or community college and is either
17	employed by the university, college, or community college full time or is on
18	a nine-month or twelve-month appointment at the university, college, or
19	community college as a faculty member.
20	(b) A licensee may possess a concealed handgun in the buildings and or
21	the grounds, whether owned or leased by the public university, public
22	college, or community college, of the public university, public college, or
23	community college where he or she is employed unless otherwise prohibited by
24	§ 5-73-306 if:
25	(1) He or she is a staff member; and
26	(2)(A) The governing board of the public university, public
27	college, or community college does not adopt a policy expressly disallowing
28	the carrying of a concealed handgun by staff members in the buildings or on
29	the grounds of the public university, public college, or community college
30	and posts notices as described in § 5-73-306(18).
31	(B) A governing board of the public university, public
32	college, or community college may adopt differing policies for the carrying
33	of a concealed handgun by staff members for different campuses, areas of a
34	campus, or individual buildings of the public university, public college, or
35	community college for which the governing board is responsible.
36	(C) A policy disallowing the carrying of a concealed

1	handgun by staff members into the public university, public college, or
2	community college expires one (1) year after the date of adoption and must be
3	readopted each year by the governing board of the public university, public
4	college, or community college to remain in effect.
5	(c) A licensee may possess a concealed handgun in the buildings and on
6	the grounds of the private university or private college where he or she is
7	employed unless otherwise prohibited by § 5-73-306 if:
8	(1) He or she is a staff member; and
9	(2) The private university or private college does not adopt a
10	policy expressly disallowing the carrying of a concealed handgun in the
11	buildings and on the grounds of the private university or private college and
12	posts notices as described in § 5-73-306(18).
13	(d) The storage of a handgun in a university or college-operated
14	student dormitory or residence hall is prohibited under § 5-73-119(e).
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
