21	SECTION 1. Ark	cansas Code § 5-73-101, concerning def	initions to be used
22	in regard to weapons, is amended to add additional subdivisions to read as		
23	follows:		
24	<u>(12) "Jo</u>	ourney" means a person has left his or	her home or the
25	curtilage of his or h	ner home either on foot, horseback, bi	cycle, or in an
26	automobile for any pu	urpose or duration; and	
27	<u>(13) "Ve</u>	ehicle" means any automobile and is co	<u>nsidered an</u>
28	extension of a person	's home, with any protections that co	nveys.

30	SECTION 2. Ark	cansas Code \S 5-73-120(b) and (c), con	cerning definitions
31	and those places where a person is not prohibited from possessing a weapon,		
32	are amended to read as follows:		
33	(b) As used in	n this section:	
34	(1) "Clu	ub" means any instrument that is speci	ally designed,
35	made, or adapted for	the purpose of inflicting serious phy	sical injury or
36	death by striking, in	ncluding a blackjack, billie, and sap;	

- 1 (2) "Handgun" means any firearm with a barrel length of less
- 2 than twelve inches (12") that is designed, made, or adapted to be fired with
- 3 one (1) hand;
- 4 (3) "Journey" means travel beyond the county in which a person
- 5 lives; and
- 6 $\frac{(4)(3)}{(3)}$ "Knife" means any bladed hand instrument three inches
- 7 (3") or longer that is capable of inflicting serious physical injury or death
- 8 by cutting or stabbing, including a dirk, a sword or spear in a cane, a
- 9 razor, an ice pick, a throwing star, a switchblade, and a butterfly knife.
- 10 (c) It is permissible to carry a weapon under this section if at the
- 11 time of the act of carrying the weapon:
- 12 (1) The person is in his or her own dwelling or, in his or her
- 13 <u>personal vehicle</u>, in his or her place of business, or on property in which he
- 14 or she has a possessory or proprietary interest;
- 15 (2) The person is a law enforcement officer, correctional
- 16 officer, or member of the armed forces acting in the course and scope of his
- 17 or her official duties;
- 18 (3) The person is assisting a law enforcement officer,
- 19 correctional officer, or member of the armed forces acting in the course and
- 20 scope of his or her official duties pursuant to the direction or request of
- 21 the law enforcement officer, correctional officer, or member of the armed
- 22 forces;
- 23 (4) The person is carrying a weapon when upon a journey, unless
- 24 the journey is through a commercial airport when presenting at the security
- 25 checkpoint in the airport or is in the person's checked baggage and is not a
- 26 lawfully declared weapon;
- 27 (5) The person is a registered commissioned security guard
- 28 acting in the course and scope of his or her duties;
- 29 (6) The person is hunting game with a handgun that may be hunted
- 30 with a handgun under rules and regulations of the Arkansas State Game and
- 31 Fish Commission or is en route to or from a hunting area for the purpose of
- 32 hunting game with a handgun;
- 33 (7)(A) The person is a certified law enforcement officer, either
- 34 on-duty or off-duty.
- 35 (B) If the person is an off-duty law enforcement officer,
- 36 he or she may be required by a public school or publicly supported

2	identification identifying the person as a law enforcement officer;		
3	(8) The person is in possession of a concealed handgun and has a		
4	valid license to carry a concealed handgun under § 5-73-301 et seq., or		
5	recognized under \S 5-73-321 and is not in a prohibited place as defined by \S		
6	5-73-306;		
7	(9) The person is a prosecuting attorney or deputy prosecuting		
8	attorney carrying a firearm under § 16-21-147; or		
9	(10) The person is in possession of a handgun and is a retired		
10	law enforcement officer with a valid concealed carry authorization issued		
11	under federal or state law.
