28 29	25-1-1001. Definitions.
30	As used in this subchapter:
31	
32	(1) "Boycott" means without an ordinary business purpose: (A) Engaging in refusals to deal;
33	<u>(B) Terminating business activities; or</u>
34	(C) Other actions that are intended to limit public
35	entities commercial relations with an industry in a discriminatory manner.
36	(2)(A) "Company" means a sole proprietorship, organization,

1	association, corporation, partnership, joint venture, limited partnership,
2	limited liability partnership, limited liability company, or other entity or
3	business association, including all wholly owned subsidiaries, majority-owned
4	subsidiaries, parent companies, or affiliates of those entities or business

6	(B) "Company" does not include a financial services
7	provider as defined in § 25-1-1001(8)(A) as created by HB1307 of the Ninety-
8	fourth General Assembly if that bill becomes an act;"
9	(3)(A) "Ordinary business purpose" means a purpose that is
10	related to business operations.
11	<u>(B) "Ordinary business purpose" does not include a purpose</u>
12	that is solely related to furthering social, political, or ideological
13	<u>interests.</u>
14	(4) "Public entity" means a state or local government entity,
15	including a:
16	(A) Department, division, agency, office, commission,
17	board, constitutional office, or other government organization;
18	(B) Political subdivision, including a city, county,
19	municipality, town, or conservation district; and
20	(C) Public school, public school district, charter school,
21	or public institution of higher education.

25	(a) Except as provided under subsection (c) of this section, a public
26	entity shall not:
27	(1) Enter into a contract with a company to acquire or dispose
28	of services, supplies, information technology, or construction unless the
29	contract includes a written certification that the person or company is not
30	currently engaged in, and agrees for the duration of the contract not to
31	engage in, a boycott of energy, fossil fuel, firearms, and ammunition
32	industries; or
33	(2) Engage in a boycott of energy, fossil fuel, firearms, and
34	ammunition industries.
35	(b) A company's statement that it is participating in boycotts of
36	energy, fossil fuel, firearms, and ammunition industries or that it has taken

1	the boycott action at the request, in compliance with, or in furtherance of
2	calls for a boycott can be considered by the Office of State Procurement as a
3	type of evidence, among others, that a company is participating in a boycott
4	of energy, fossil fuel, firearms, and ammunition industries.
5	(c) This section does not apply to:
6	(1) A company that fails to meet the requirements under
7	subsection (a) of this section but offers to provide the goods or services
8	for at least twenty percent (20%) less than the lowest certifying business;
9	<u>or</u>
10	(2) Contracts with a total potential value of less than seventy-
11	five thousand dollars (\$75,000).
