# A BILL FOR AN ACT CONCERNING ALLOWING CONCEALED HANDGUN PERMIT HOLDERS TO

101 CONCERNING ALLOWING CONCEALED HANDGUN PERMIT HOLDERS TO CARRY CONCEALED HANDGUNS ON SCHOOL GROUNDS.

## **Bill Summary**

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. With certain exceptions, current law prohibits a concealed carry permit holder from carrying a concealed handgun on public elementary, middle, junior high, or high school grounds. The bill removes this limitation. The bill prohibits a local government from prohibiting carrying a concealed handgun on school grounds by a person who has a valid concealed carry permit.

1	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:
2	SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 18-12-214, add
3	(1)(c)(III); and <b>repeal</b> (3) as follows:
4	18-12-214. Authority granted by permit - carrying restrictions
5	- local authority. (1) (c) (III) NOTWITHSTANDING THE AUTHORITY
6	GRANTED PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION $(1)(c)(I)$ OF THIS SECTION, A LOCAL
7	GOVERNMENT MAY NOT PROHIBIT A PERSON WHO HOLDS A VALID PERMIT
8	TO CARRY A CONCEALED HANDGUN, INCLUDING A VALID TEMPORARY
9	EMERGENCY PERMIT, FROM CARRYING A CONCEALED HANDGUN ONTO THE
10	REAL PROPERTY, OR INTO ANY IMPROVEMENTS ERECTED THEREON, OF A
11	PUBLIC ELEMENTARY, MIDDLE, JUNIOR HIGH, OR HIGH SCHOOL.
12	(3) A permit issued pursuant to this part 2 does not authorize a
13	person to carry a concealed handgun onto the real property, or into any
14	improvements erected thereon, of a public elementary, middle, junior
15	high, or high school; except that:
16	(a) A permittee may have a handgun on the real property of the
17	public school so long as the handgun remains in his or her vehicle and, if
18	the permittee is not in the vehicle, the handgun is in a compartment within
19	the vehicle and the vehicle is locked;
20	(b) A permittee who is employed or retained by contract by a
21	school district or charter school as a school security officer may carry a
22	concealed handgun onto the real property, or into any improvement
23	erected thereon, of a public elementary, middle, junior high, or high
24	school while the permittee is on duty;
25	(c) A permittee may carry a concealed handgun on undeveloped
26	real property owned by a school district that is used for hunting or other

2	SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 18-12-105.5, amend
3	(3) introductory portion and (3)(d.5); and <b>repeal</b> (3)(d) as follows:
4	18-12-105.5. Unlawfully carrying a weapon - unlawful
5	possession of weapons - school, college, or university grounds. (3) It
6	shall not be IS NOT an offense under this section if:
7	(d) The person, at the time of carrying a concealed weapon, held
8	a valid written permit to carry a concealed weapon issued pursuant to
9	section 18-12-105.1, as said section existed prior to its repeal; except that
10	it shall be an offense under this section if the person was carrying a
11	concealed handgun in violation of the provisions of section 18-12-214
12	<del>(3); or</del>
13	(d.5) The weapon involved was a handgun and the person held a
14	valid permit to carry a concealed handgun or a temporary emergency
15	permit issued pursuant to part 2 of this article; except that it shall be an
16	offense under this section if the person was carrying a concealed handgun
17	in violation of the provisions of section 18-12-214 (3) ARTICLE 12; or
18	SECTION 3. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
19	determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
20	preservation of the public peace, health, or safety.
