A BILL FOR AN ACT CONCERNING REQUIRING CERTAIN APPLICANTS FOR CONCEALED HANDGUN PERMITS TO COMPLETE A HANDGUN TRAINING CLASS ON THE PHYSICAL GROUNDS WHERE THE CERTIFIED INSTRUCTOR OF THE COURSE OFFERS THE COURSE.

Bill Summary

Under current law, an applicant for a concealed handgun permit is required to demonstrate competence with a handgun. An applicant may

SENATE Amended 2nd Reading March 8, 2013 demonstrate such competence through various means, including the submission of a training certificate showing that the applicant has completed a handgun training class.

The bill provides that, for the purpose of the concealed handgun application process, a "handgun training class" does not include any firearms safety course that allows a person to complete any portion of the course:

- Via the internet or an electronic device; or
- ! In any location other than the physical location where the certified instructor offers the course.

Definitions.** As used in this part 2, unless the context 5 otherwise requires: 6 (5) (a) "Handgun training class" means: 7 (a) (I) A law enforcement training firearms safety course; 8 (b) (II) A firearms safety course offered by a law enforcement 9 agency, an institution of higher education, or a public or private 10 institution or organization or firearms training school, that is open to the 11 general public and is taught by a certified instructor; or 12 (c) (III) A firearms safety course or class that is offered and taught 13 by a certified instructor. 14 (b) NOTWITHSTANDING PARAGRAPH (a) OF THIS SUBSECTION (5), "HANDGUN TRAINING CLASS" DOES NOT INCLUDE ANY FIREARMS SAFETY 15 16 COURSE THAT ALLOWS A PERSON TO COMPLETE THE ENTIRE COURSE: 17 (I) VIA THE INTERNET OR AN ELECTRONIC DEVICE; OR 18 (II) IN ANY LOCATION OTHER THAN THE PHYSICAL LOCATION 19 WHERE THE CERTIFIED INSTRUCTOR OFFERS THE COURSE.
