A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 7 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 damage to and intrusion upon property, so as to create the crime of home invasion; to provide
- 3 for a definition; to provide for penalties; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

5 SECTION 1.

- 6 Chapter 7 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to damage to and
- 7 intrusion upon property, is amended by adding a new article to read as follows:

8 "ARTICLE 1A

- 9 <u>16-7-5.</u>
- 10 (a) As used in this Code section, the term 'dwelling' shall have the same meaning as
- provided in Code Section 16-7-1.
- 12 (b) A person commits the offense of home invasion when, without authority and with
- intent to commit a forcible felony or forcible misdemeanor therein and while in possession
- of a firearm or any other weapon, he or she enters or remains within the dwelling house of
- another while such dwelling house is occupied by any person with authority to be present
- 16 therein.
- 17 (c) A person convicted of the offense of home invasion shall be guilty of a felony and,
- 18 <u>upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by imprisonment for life or imprisonment for</u>
- not less than ten nor more than 20 years and by a fine of not less than \$10,000.00 nor more
- 20 than \$100,000.00.
- 21 (d) Adjudication of guilt or imposition of sentence shall not be suspended, probated,
- deferred, or withheld for any offense punishable under this Code section.

(e) A sentence imposed under this Code section shall be imposed separately from and
 consecutive to a sentence for any other offense related to the act or acts establishing the
 offense under this Code section."
