A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1 To amend Part 1 of Article 4 of Chapter 11 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia 2 Annotated, relating to general provisions relative to dangerous instrumentalities and 3 practices, so as to change provisions relating to discharging a gun or pistol near a public 4 highway or street; to provide for definitions; to provide for exceptions; to provide for related 5 matters; to provide for an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

SECTION 1.

8 Part 1 of Article 4 of Chapter 11 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,

- 9 relating to general provisions relative to dangerous instrumentalities and practices, is
- 10 amended by revising Code Section 16-11-103, relating to discharging a gun or pistol near a
- 11 public highway or street, as follows:

12 *"*16-11-103.

13 (a) As used in this Code section, the term:

- 14 <u>(1) 'Firearm' means any handgun, rifle, or shotgun.</u>
- 15 (2) 'Public highway' means every public street, road, and highway in this state.
- 16 (3) 'Sport shooting range' means an area designated and operated by a person or entity
- 17 for the sport shooting of firearms, target practice, trapshooting, skeet shooting, or
- 18 shooting sporting clays and not available for such use by the general public without
- 19 payment of a fee, membership contribution, or dues or without the invitation of an
- 20 <u>authorized person, or any area so designated and operated by a unit of government,</u>
- 21 regardless of the terms of admission thereto.
- 22 (4) 'Unit of government' means any of the departments, agencies, authorities, or political
- 23 <u>subdivisions of the state, cities, municipal corporations, townships, or villages and any</u>
- 24 <u>of their respective departments, agencies, or authorities.</u>
- 25 (b) Except as provided in subsection (c) or (d) of this Code section, it shall be unlawful for
- 26 <u>any person</u>, A person is guilty of a misdemeanor when, without legal justification, he

- 27 discharges a gun or pistol to discharge a firearm on or within 50 yards of a public highway
- 28 or street.
- 29 (c) This Code section shall not apply to a discharge of a firearm which occurs within 50
- 30 yards of a public highway if such discharge occurs at:
- 31 (1) An indoor or outdoor sport shooting range;
- 32 (2) Facilities used for firearm or hunting safety courses sponsored by a unit of
- 33 government, nonprofit corporation, or commercial enterprise; or
- 34 (3) The business location of any person, firm, retail dealer, wholesale dealer,
- 35 pawnbroker, or corporation licensed as a firearm dealer pursuant to Chapter 16 of Title
- 36 <u>43.</u>
- 37 (d) This Code section shall not apply to any person engaged in legal hunting which occurs
- 38 within 50 yards of a public highway; provided, however, that such exception shall not
- 39 <u>apply to legal hunting within an incorporated municipality of this state.</u>
- 40 (e) Any person who violates subsection (b) of the Code section shall be guilty of a
- 41 <u>misdemeanor.</u>"

SECTION 2.

- 43 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
- 44 without such approval.

46 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
