WHEREAS, as the president and CEO of Law Enforcement Services, Marcia wrote and taught training programs for women in law enforcement and attended a trade mission to Trinidad and Tobago, where she shared her knowledge and experiences with the law enforcement community there and trained and helped to certify women in the proper handling and use of a firearm; and

WHEREAS, someone in the law enforcement community aptly summed up Marcia's commitment when he said, "I have found that the building blocks of protecting others is nobility, integrity, courage, and enthusiasm, in which we have found to be the exact traits that defined Sgt. Dell. Moreover, as a trailblazer, Sgt. Dell has opened the doors for many of us who came behind her, her dedication and professionalism encourages us to do our best, her kindness and her smile will never be forgotten"; and 14
