A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Part 1 of Article 4 of Chapter 11 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia
- 2 Annotated, relating to general provisions relative to dangerous instrumentalities and
- 3 practices, so as to make it unlawful to discharge a firearm in an act of celebration or
- 4 ceremony; to provide for definitions; to provide for exceptions; to provide for criminal
- 5 penalties; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Part 1 of Article 4 of Chapter 11 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 9 relating to general provisions relative to dangerous instrumentalities and practices, is
- amended by revising Code Section 16-11-105, relating to the discharge of firearm on
- 11 Sunday, as follows:
- 12 "16-11-105.
- 13 (a) As used in this Code section, the term 'firearm' means any handgun, rifle, or shotgun.
- 14 (b) It shall be unlawful for any person to fire or discharge a firearm into the air or
- otherwise as an act of celebration or ceremony.
- 16 (c) This Code section shall not apply to law enforcement officers or members of the
- National Guard or of the armed forces of the United States in the performance of their
- 18 <u>official duties.</u>
- 19 (d) Any person who violates this Code section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall
- 20 <u>be punished by a fine of \$1,000.00 and, in the discretion of the court, be imprisoned for not</u>
- 21 more than 12 months Reserved."

SECTION 2.

23 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
