## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 1 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 general provisions regarding state government, so as to prohibit any agency of this state, any
- 3 political subdivision of this state, any employee of any agency of this state or any political
- 4 subdivision of this state, or any member of the Georgia National Guard from assisting an
- 5 agency of the armed forces of the United States in the investigation, prosecution, or
- 6 detainment of any citizen of the United States under certain circumstances; to provide for
- 7 related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

9 **SECTION 1.** 

- 10 Chapter 1 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to general
- provisions regarding state government, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as
- 12 follows:
- 13 "<u>50-1-10.</u>
- 14 (a) Subject to subsection (b) of this Code section, notwithstanding any provision of law
- to the contrary, no agency of this state, no political subdivision of this state, no employee
- of any agency of this state or any political subdivision of this state acting in his or her
- official capacity, and no member of the Georgia National Guard on active state service
- 18 shall aid an agency of the armed forces of the United States in any investigation,
- prosecution, or detention of any person pursuant to Section 1021 of the federal National
- 20 <u>Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2012, if such aid would place that state agency,</u>
- 21 <u>political subdivision, employee, or member of the Georgia National Guard in violation of</u>
- 22 <u>the United States Constitution, the Constitution of this state, or any law of this state.</u>
- 23 (b) Subsection (a) of this Code section shall not apply to participation by state or local law
- 24 <u>enforcement or the Georgia National Guard in a joint task force, partnership, or other</u>
- 25 <u>similar cooperative agreement with federal law enforcement if that joint task force,</u>
- 26 partnership, or similar cooperative agreement is not for the purpose of investigating,

27 prosecuting, or detaining any person pursuant to Section 1021 of the federal National

28 <u>Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2012."</u>

SECTION 2.

30 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
