A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending the Forsyth County Sheriff's Department; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, on June 6, 2014, the Forsyth County Sheriff's Department resisted an armed
- 3 attack that was launched against the Forsyth County courthouse in Cumming, Georgia; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Deputy Daniel Rush, the first deputy at the scene of the attack, was shot and
- 5 injured while attempting to stop the perpetrator from attacking deputies, government
- 6 workers, and civilians inside the courthouse and in the surrounding area; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Deputy Bobby Francis displayed exemplary leadership by leading the way to
- 8 the courthouse through a large volume of gunfire and rendering lifesaving aid to Deputy
- 9 Rush before assisting with physically evacuating Deputy Rush from the scene; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Deputy Brian Chatham courageously and selflessly shielded injured Deputy
- Rush with his body so he would not sustain further injuries from the gunfire that was raining
- 12 down upon them; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Lieutenant Matt Allen moved to stop the attacker from completing his assault
- on the courthouse and assisted with physically evacuating Deputy Rush from the scene; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Corporal Matt Scott applied a tourniquet to Deputy Rush and continued to treat
- 16 his wounds until he was able to receive proper medical care; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Deputy Pat Sternik engaged the attacker with his pistol and shotgun from the
- 18 lobby through the front door of the courthouse while Deputy James White and Deputy Brian
- 19 Dublin engaged him with their pistols through the window of the Solicitor's Office and
- 20 Deputy Bill Keeton engaged the perpetrator with his pistol through the window of Courtroom

22 WHEREAS, Deputy William Mouret, Deputy Robin Regan, Lieutenant Sebastian Strano,

- 23 and Sergeant Kenny Hughes joined the firefight outside the courthouse, fighting to vanquish
- 24 the attacker and restore peace and safety to the scene; and
- 25 WHEREAS, Lieutenant James Poe exhibited exemplary leadership by controlling the active
- scene on the courthouse lawn during the shooting and leading the approach to the attacker
- and his vehicle after the shooting; and
- 28 WHEREAS, these courageous men put all thoughts of their personal safety and well-being
- 29 aside and responded to the call to protect their fellow law enforcement professionals,
- 30 courthouse employees, and civilians, and their selfless actions in stopping this attack are
- 31 deserving of honor.
- 32 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
- 33 commend the Forsyth County Sheriff's Department for their heroic actions on June 6, 2014.
- 34 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
- 35 to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the Forsyth County
- 36 Sheriff's Department.
