## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 11 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 offenses against public order and safety, so as to require that printed information on firearm
- 3 safety be given to each applicant for a weapons carry license or renewal license; to provide
- 4 for definitions; to provide that certain buyers of firearms receive from the seller printed
- 5 information on firearm safety; to require a website on firearm safety by the commissioner of
- 6 public safety; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
- 7 purposes.

## 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

9 SECTION 1.

- 10 Chapter 11 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to offenses against
- public order and safety, is amended by adding a new subsection to Code Section 16-11-129,
- 12 relating to weapons carry license, temporary renewal permit, mandamus, and verification of
- license, to read as follows:
- 14 "(a.1) Upon receipt of an application for a weapons carry license or renewal license, the
- 15 judge of the probate court shall provide to such applicant printed information which shall
- direct such applicant to the website provided for under Code Section 16-11-175 for
- information on firearm safety."

18 SECTION 2.

- 19 Said chapter is further amended by adding new paragraphs to Code Section 16-11-171,
- 20 relating to definitions, to read as follows:
- 21 "(3.1) 'Gun show' means any event at which 25 or more firearms are offered or exhibited
- for sale, transfer, or exchange.
- 23 (3.2) 'Gun show vendor' means any person who offers for sale, exhibits, sells, transfers,
- 24 <u>or exchanges one or more firearms at a gun show, regardless of whether or not the person</u>

26	exhibit, sell, transfer, or exchange one or more firearms."
25	arranges with the gun show promoter for a fixed location from which to offer for sale,

- 28 Said chapter is further amended by adding new Code sections to Part 5 of Article 4, relating
- 29 to Brady Law regulations, to read as follows:
- 30 "<u>16-11-174.</u>
- 31 All transfers or purchases of firearms from a gun show vendor or licensed dealer to a buyer
- 32 <u>shall include to the buyer printed information which shall direct such buyer to the website</u>
- provided for under Code Section 16-11-175 for information on firearm safety.
- 34 <u>16-11-175.</u>
- 35 The commissioner of public safety shall maintain a public website which shall provide
- 36 <u>information on the safe and proper use and storage of firearms and a directory of persons</u>
- or entities in this state who render instruction in firearm safety and shooting. The
- 38 <u>commissioner of public safety may promulgate rules and regulations for the inclusion of</u>
- 39 persons or entities within such directory."
- 40 SECTION 4.
- 41 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
