A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Part 5 of Article 4 of Chapter 11 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia
- 2 Annotated, relating to Brady Law Regulations, so as to require a five-day waiting period for
- 3 the purchase or transfer of certain firearms; to provide for exceptions; to provide for criminal
- 4 penalties; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Part 5 of Article 4 of Chapter 11 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 8 relating to Brady Law Regulations, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as
- 9 follows:
- 10 "16-1<u>1-172.1</u>
- 11 (a) All transfers or purchases of firearms conducted by a licensed importer, licensed
- manufacturer, or licensed dealer shall not be completed until the fifth day after the
- initiation of such transfer or purchase; provided, however, that the calculation of the five
- 14 days shall not include Saturdays, Sundays, or state or federal holidays and provided,
- 15 further, that the NICS check provided for under Code Section 16-11-172 may be conducted
- within the five days.

17 (b) Licensed importers, licensed manufacturers, and licensed dealers shall, during normal

- business hours, make records available for inspection by any law enforcement agency for
- 19 purposes of any criminal investigation.
- 20 (c) Subsection (a) of this Code section shall not apply when a firearm is being purchased
- by, or transferred to:
- 22 (1) The holder of a weapons carry license issued pursuant to Code Section 16-11-129;
- 23 <u>or</u>
- 24 (2) Any person provided for under Code Section 16-11-130.
- 25 (d) Any licensed importer, licensed manufacturer, or licensed dealer who violates this
- 26 Code section, or any purchaser or transferee who uses fraud or false representation to avoid
- 27 the requirements of subsection (a) of this Code section, shall be guilty of a felony and,
- 28 upon conviction, shall be punished by imprisonment for not less than one nor more than
- 29 <u>five years."</u>

30 SECTION 2.

31 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
