The Senate Natural Resources and the Environment Committee offered the following substitute to HB 207:

# A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To amend Article 1 of Chapter 2 of Title 27 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to licenses, permits, and stamps for hunting, trapping, or fishing, so as to authorize a special turkey-hunting season for certain young and mobility impaired hunters; to amend Code Section 27-3-15 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to wildlife hunting seasons and bag limits, so as to establish the firearms deer hunting season for certain counties; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

### 8 **SECTION 1.** 9 Article 1 of Chapter 2 of Title 27 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to 10 licenses, permits, and stamps for hunting, trapping, or fishing, is amended by adding a new 11 Code section to read as follows: 12 "27-2-4.4. 13 (a) As used in this Code section, the term 'mobility impaired person' means any person 14 who has been verified by a doctor of medicine currently licensed to practice by the Georgia 15 Composite Medical Board, the State Board of Examiners in Osteopathy, or an equivalent body of another state to have any one of the following permanent conditions: 16 17 (1) Dependance upon a wheelchair or similar device for ambulation; 18 (2) Hemiplegia; 19 (3) Monoplegia; 20 (4) Paraplegia; or 21 (5) Single-leg amputation above the knee. 22 (b) The board shall promulgate rules and regulations authorizing the hunting of turkeys 23 during an extended open season to: 24 (1) Any person who is 16 years of age or younger; or 25 (2) Any mobility impaired person.
