Public Safety – Handgun Qualification License – Qualified Handgun Instructors and Permit Holders

4FOR the purpose of establishing that certain provisions relating to a handgun qualification license do not apply to a certain qualified handgun instructor; $\mathbf{5}$ 6 establishing that a person may purchase, rent, or receive a handgun without a 7handgun qualification license if the person is a certain qualified handgun 8 instructor and is not otherwise prohibited under State or federal law; requiring 9 the Secretary of State Police to issue a handgun gualification license to a certain 10 person who meets the requirements for a certain permit to carry, wear, or transport a handgun; and generally relating to handgun qualification licenses. 11

2 (d) "Permit" means a permit issued by the Secretary to carry, wear, or 3 transport a handgun.

5 (d) The Secretary [may] SHALL issue a handgun qualification license, 6 without an additional application or fee, to a person who:

7 (1) meets the requirements for issuance of a permit under this section; 8 and

9 (2) does not have a handgun qualification license issued under § 10 5-117.1 of this title.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effectOctober 1, 2014.
