AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 280
(First Reading File Bill)

On page 1, strike “**and Bailey**” and substitute “**Bailey, Smith, Waldstreicher, Sydnor, West, Muse, Folden, James, Henson, Love, McKay, and Charles**”.

On page 4, in line 26, strike the brackets.

On page 5, in line 11, strike “**SERVICE IN THE UNIFORMED SERVICES**” and substitute “**UNIFORMED SERVICES DUTY**”.

On page 6, in line 4, after “(a)” insert “**(1)**”; strike beginning with the comma in line 4 down through “**HAS**” in line 5 and substitute “**THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.**”

(2) “ACTIVE SERVICE MEMBER” HAS”;

after line 6, insert:

“(3) “SERVICE MEMBER” HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § 9-901 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE.”;

in lines 9, 12, and 14, in each instance, after “forces]” insert “**SERVICE**”; in lines 9, 13, and 15, in each instance, strike “**OF THE UNIFORMED SERVICES**”; in line 10, after the third “the” insert “**FORMER OR ACTIVE SERVICE**”; in lines 13, 15, and 17, in each instance, after “the” insert “**FORMER OR ACTIVE SERVICE**”.

On page 11, in line 7, strike “**SERVICE IN THE UNIFORMED SERVICES**” and substitute “**UNIFORMED SERVICES DUTY**”.

On page 12, after line 9, insert:

“(A) “VETERAN” HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § 9-901 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE.

(B)”;

in line 11, strike the bracket; and strike beginning with the bracket in line 15 down through “**ARTICLE**” in line 16.

On page 13, in line 25, strike “service **IN**”; in line 30, strike the first opening bracket; and in the same line, strike “**] A**”.

On page 17, in line 24, strike the first opening bracket; and in the same line, strike the closing bracket.
