An Act relative to change of address for firearm licensing.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 129B of chapter 140 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by deleting the following in lines 341 through 342:- “Failure  
3 to so notify shall be cause for revocation or suspension of such card.”

4           SECTION 2. Section 131 of chapter 140 of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby  
5 amended by deleting the following in lines 350 through 352:- “Failure to so notify shall be cause  
6 for revocation or suspension of said license.”
