No person shall be appointed as agent, assistant, deputy or inspector under the provisions of the 4 liquor control law who shall have been convicted of or 5 against whom any indictment may be pending for any offense; 6 7 nor shall any person be appointed as such agent, assistant, 8 deputy or inspector who is not of good character or who is 9 not a citizen of the United States, and who is not [or has not been] a resident taxpaying citizen of the state [for a 10 period of three years previous to his] at the time of his or 11 her appointment; or who is not able to read and write the 12 English language or who does not possess ordinary physical 13 strength and who is not able to pass such physical and 14 15 mental examination as the [majority of a board, consisting 16 of the governor, lieutenant governor, attorney general, and 17 the] supervisor of [liquor] alcohol and tobacco control may prescribe. 18 2.
