Amend <u>SS/Senate</u> Bill No. <u>823</u>, Page <u>1</u>, Section <u>A</u>, Line <u>11</u>,

by inserting after all of said line the following: 2 "167.630. 1. Each school board may authorize a school 3 nurse licensed under chapter 335 who is employed by the 4 school district and for whom the board is responsible for to 5 maintain an adequate supply of prefilled auto syringes of 6 7 epinephrine with fifteen-hundredths milligram or three-8 tenths milligram delivery at the school. The nurse shall 9 recommend to the school board the number of prefilled epinephrine auto syringes that the school should maintain. 10

2. To obtain prefilled epinephrine auto syringes for a 11 school district, a prescription written by a licensed 12 physician, a physician's assistant, or nurse practitioner is 13 required. For such prescriptions, the school district shall 14 15 be designated as the patient, the nurse's name shall be 16 required, and the prescription shall be filled at a licensed 17 pharmacy.

3. A school nurse [or], contracted agent trained by a 18 nurse, or other school employee trained by and supervised by 19 the nurse, shall have the discretion to use an epinephrine 20 21 auto syringe on any student the school nurse [or], trained employee or trained contracted agent believes is having a 22 23 life-threatening anaphylactic reaction based on the training in recognizing an acute episode of an anaphylactic 24 reaction. The provisions of section 167.624 concerning 25 immunity from civil liability for trained employees 26

27 administering lifesaving methods shall apply to trained 28 employees administering a prefilled auto syringe under this 29 section. <u>Trained contracted agents shall have immunity from</u> 30 <u>civil liability for administering a prefilled auto syringe</u> 31 under this section."; and
