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1 (b) An additional fee, not to exceed ten dollars (\$10.00), shall be collected by the sheriff 2 from an applicant for a permit to pay for the costs of processing the applicant's fingerprints, if 3 fingerprints were required to be taken. This fee shall be retained by the sheriff."

4 **SECTION 6.** Notwithstanding the provisions of this act, any concealed handgun 5 permit issued prior to December 1, 2021, and expiring on or after that date, may be renewed 6 pursuant to the statutory provisions existing prior to this act.

7 **SECTION 7.** This act becomes effective December 1, 2021, and applies to all 8 permits issued or renewed on or after that date.
