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**SENATE BILL 43** Short Title: Protect Religious Meeting Places. (Public) Sponsors: Senators Britt, Daniel, and Johnson (Primary Sponsors). Referred to: Rules and Operations of the Senate February 3, 2021 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 2 AN ACT TO ENACT THE RELIGIOUS ASSEMBLY SECURITY AND PROTECTION ACT 3 OF 2021. 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 5 SECTION 1. This act shall be known as "The Religious Assembly Security and 6 Protection Act of 2021." 7 **SECTION 2.** G.S. 14-269.2(a) is amended by adding a new subdivision to read: 8 "(1c) School operating hours. - Any time when curricular or extracurricular activities are taking place on the premises and any time when the premises are 9 10 being used for educational, instructional, or school-sponsored activities." **SECTION 3.** G.S. 14-269.2 is amended by adding a new subsection to read: 12 "(k1) For the purposes of this subsection, property owned by a local board of education or county commission shall not be construed as a building that is a place of religious worship as 13 defined in G.S. 14-54.1. The provisions of this section shall not apply to a person who has a 14 concealed handgun permit that is valid under Article 54B of this Chapter, or who is exempt from 15 obtaining a permit pursuant to that Article, if all of the following conditions apply: 16 The person possesses and carries a handgun on educational property other than 17 (1) an institution of higher education as defined by G.S. 116-143.1 or a nonpublic, 18 postsecondary educational institution. 19 20 The educational property is the location of both a school and a building that is (2) a place of religious worship as defined in G.S. 14-54.1. 21 22 The weapon is a handgun. (3) 23 The handgun is only possessed and carried on educational property outside of (4) 24 the school operating hours." 25 **SECTION 4.** G.S. 14-415.11(c) reads as rewritten: Except as provided in G.S. 14-415.27, a permit does not authorize a person to carry 26 27 a concealed handgun in any of the following: Areas prohibited by G.S. 14-269.2, <del>14-269.3, and 14-277.2.</del> except as allowed 28 (1) 29 under G.S. 14-269.2(k1).



Areas prohibited by G.S. 14-269.3 and G.S. 14-277.2.

**SECTION 5.** This act becomes effective December 1, 2021.
