6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to motor vehicles; amending 47 O.S.
8 2011, Sections 1135.3 and 1135.5, as last amended by
9 Sections 2 and 3, Chapter 372, O.S.L. 2014 (47 O.S.
10 Supp. 2014, Sections 1135.3 and 1135.5), which relate
11 to specialty license plates; providing for issuance
12 of license plate to increase awareness of childhood
13 cancer; providing for issuance of license plate to
14 demonstrate support for 911 dispatchers; providing
15 for issuance of license plate demonstrating support
16 for the Oklahoma Sports Hall of Fame; providing for
17 design of license plate; authorizing certain
18 licensing agreement; providing for distribution of
19 certain proceeds; and providing an effective date.

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

21 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.3, as
22 last amended by Section 2, Chapter 372, O.S.L. 2014 (47 O.S. Supp.
23 2014, Section 1135.3), is amended to read as follows:

24 Section 1135.3 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license
plates to persons wishing to demonstrate support, interest, or
membership to or for an organization, occupation, cause or other
subject as provided by this section.

1 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
2 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
3 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
4 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
5 registered for the current year.

6 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax
7 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall
8 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates.
9 The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain
10 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor
11 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be
12 issued on a staggered system.

13 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
14 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept
15 applications for special license plates authorized under this
16 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's
17 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount
18 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
19 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
20 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents
21 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for
22 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for
23 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
24 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

1 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates
2 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1,
3 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of
4 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special
5 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license
6 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration
7 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be
8 removed from the vehicle.

9 Except as otherwise provided in this section, for special
10 license plates authorized on or after July 1, 2004, no special
11 license plates shall be developed or issued by the Tax Commission
12 until the Commission receives one hundred (100) prepaid applications
13 therefor. The prepaid applications must be received by the Tax
14 Commission within one hundred eighty (180) days of the effective
15 date of the authorization or the authority to issue shall be null
16 and void. In the event one hundred (100) prepaid applications are
17 not received by the Tax Commission within such prescribed time
18 period any payment so received shall be refunded accordingly.

19 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as
20 follows:

21 1. Round and Square Dance License Plates - such plates shall be
22 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
23 round and square dancing;

1 2. National Association for the Advancement of Colored People
2 License Plates - such plates shall be designed, subject to the
3 criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission by the NAACP, and
4 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the NAACP;

5 3. National Rifle Association License Plates - such plates
6 shall be designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the
7 Tax Commission by the National Rifle Association, and issued to any
8 person wishing to demonstrate support for the National Rifle
9 Association;

10 4. Masonic Fraternity License Plates - such plates shall be
11 designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a member of
12 a Masonic Fraternity of Oklahoma. Such persons may apply for a
13 Masonic Fraternity license plate for each vehicle with a rated
14 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of a Masonic
15 Fraternity membership or upon the presentment of an application for
16 a Masonic Fraternity license plate authorized and approved by the
17 Grand Lodge of Oklahoma. The license plates shall be designed in
18 consultation with the Masonic Fraternities of Oklahoma and shall
19 contain the Masonic emblem;

20 5. Shriner's Hospitals for Burned and Crippled Children License
21 Plates - such plates shall be designed to demonstrate support for
22 Shriner's Hospitals for Burned and Crippled Children and shall be
23 issued to any resident of this state who is a member of a Shriner's
24 Temple in Oklahoma. The license plate shall be designed in

1 consultation with the Shriner's Temples in Oklahoma and shall
2 contain the Shriner's emblem;

3 6. Balloonists License Plate - such plates shall be designed
4 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for hot air
5 ballooning in this state;

6 7. Order of the Eastern Star License Plates - such plates shall
7 be designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a member
8 of an Order of the Eastern Star. Such persons may apply for an
9 Order of the Eastern Star license plate for each vehicle with a
10 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of an
11 Order of the Eastern Star membership or upon the presentment of an
12 application for an Order of the Eastern Star license plate
13 authorized and approved by the organization. The license plate
14 shall be designed in consultation with the Order of the Eastern Star
15 and shall contain the Order of the Eastern Star emblem;

16 8. Knights of Columbus License Plates - such plates shall be
17 designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a member of
18 the Knights of Columbus. Such persons may apply for a Knights of
19 Columbus license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
20 capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of a Knights of Columbus
21 membership or upon the presentment of an application for a Knights
22 of Columbus license plate authorized and approved by the
23 organization. The license plate shall be designed in consultation
24

1 with the Knights of Columbus and shall contain the Knights of
2 Columbus emblem;

3 9. Jaycees License Plates - such plates shall be designed and
4 issued to members of the Jaycees. Persons applying for such license
5 plate must show proof of membership in the Jaycees. The license
6 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Jaycees;

7 10. Ducks Unlimited License Plates - such plates shall be
8 designed and issued to members of Ducks Unlimited. Persons applying
9 for and renewing such license plates must show proof of tag
10 membership in Ducks Unlimited. The license plates shall be designed
11 in consultation with Ducks Unlimited;

12 11. Kiwanis International License Plates - such plates shall be
13 designed and issued to members of Kiwanis International. Persons
14 applying for such license plate must show proof of membership in
15 Kiwanis International. The license plates shall be designed in
16 consultation with Kiwanis International;

17 12. Certified Public Accountants License Plates - such plates
18 shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a
19 Certified Public Accountant. Such persons may apply for a Certified
20 Public Accountant license plate for each vehicle with a rated
21 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of status as a
22 Certified Public Accountant. The license plates shall be designed
23 in consultation with the Oklahoma Society of Certified Public
24 Accountants;

1 13. Civil Emergency Management License Plates - such plates
2 shall be designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate
3 support for the state civil emergency management system. Persons
4 applying for such license plate must show proof of official
5 affiliation by presenting a nonexpired proof of employment,
6 affiliation or retirement in the form of an identification card or
7 letter on official letterhead from a municipal, county or state
8 emergency management department head;

9 14. Civilian Conservation Corps License Plates - such plates
10 shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax
11 Commission, by the Civilian Conservation Corps Association, and
12 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support of the Civilian
13 Conservation Corps;

14 15. Rotarian License Plates - such plates shall be designed and
15 issued to any resident of this state who is a member of a Rotarian
16 Club of Oklahoma. Such persons may apply for a Rotarian license
17 plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton
18 or less upon proof of a Rotarian Club membership or upon the
19 presentment of an application for a Rotarian license plate
20 authorized and approved by a Rotarian Club of Oklahoma. The license
21 plates shall be designed in consultation with the five Rotarian
22 District Governors and shall contain the Rotarian emblem;

23 16. Benevolent Protective Order of Elks - such plates shall be
24 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission,

1 by the Benevolent Protective Order of Elks, and issued to any
2 resident of this state who is a member of the Benevolent Protective
3 Order of Elks;

4 17. Humane Society License Plates - such plates shall be
5 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
6 the Humane Society of the United States. The plates shall be issued
7 to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to
8 a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate
9 shall contain the official Humane Society logo;

10 18. Oklahoma Mustang Club - such plates shall be designed,
11 subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission, by the
12 Oklahoma Mustang Club, and issued to any resident of this state who
13 is a member of the Oklahoma Mustang Club. Such persons may apply
14 for an Oklahoma Mustang Club license plate upon presentment of proof
15 of membership in the Oklahoma Mustang Club. The plates shall be
16 issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from
17 one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates;

18 19. American Business Clubs (AMBUCS) License Plates - such
19 plates shall be designed and issued to members of American Business
20 Clubs. Persons applying for such license plate must show proof of
21 membership in AMBUCS. The license plates shall be designed in
22 consultation with American Business Clubs;

23 20. West Point 200th Anniversary License Plates - such plates
24 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to commemorate

1 the Two Hundredth Anniversary of the founding of the United States
2 Military Academy at West Point, New York. The license plates shall
3 be designed in consultation with the West Point Society of Central
4 Oklahoma;

5 21. Oklahoma Aquarium License Plate - such plates shall be
6 designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
7 the Oklahoma Aquarium. The license plates shall be designed in
8 consultation with the Oklahoma Aquarium;

9 22. The Pride of Broken Arrow License Plates - such plates
10 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
11 support for The Pride of Broken Arrow marching band. The plates
12 shall be designed in consultation with the Broken Arrow Public
13 School System;

14 23. Fellowship of Christian Athletes License Plates - such
15 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Fellowship of
16 Christian Athletes and issued to members and supporters of the
17 Fellowship of Christian Athletes;

18 24. Parrothead Club License Plates - such plates shall be
19 designed and issued to members and supporters of the Parrothead
20 Club. The license plate shall be issued to any person in any
21 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven as
22 for personalized license plates;

23 25. Oklahoma Bicycling Coalition License Plates - such plates
24 shall be designed and issued to any person who is a member of the

1 Oklahoma Bicycling Coalition. The license plates shall be designed
2 in consultation with the Oklahoma Bicycling Coalition;

3 26. Electric Lineman License Plate - such plates shall be
4 designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
5 Oklahoma's electric linemen. The license plates shall be designed
6 in consultation with the Oklahoma Electric Superintendent's
7 Association;

8 27. Alpha Kappa Alpha License Plate - such plates shall be
9 designed and issued to any person who is a member of Alpha Kappa
10 Alpha Sorority. The license plates shall be designed in
11 consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter of Alpha Kappa Alpha
12 Sorority;

13 28. The National Pan-Hellenic Council Incorporated License
14 Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any person
15 wishing to demonstrate support to any of the nine sororities and
16 fraternities recognized by the National Pan-Hellenic Council
17 Incorporated. The license plates shall be designed in consultation
18 with the Oklahoma Chapter of the National Pan-Hellenic Council
19 Incorporated;

20 29. Organ, Eye and Tissue License Plate - such plates shall be
21 designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support and
22 increase awareness for organ, eye and tissue donation. The license
23 plates shall be designed in consultation with the State Department
24 of Health;

1 30. Central Oklahoma Habitat for Humanity License Plate - such
2 plates shall be designed and issued to persons wishing to
3 demonstrate support and increase awareness for Habitat for Humanity.
4 The license plate shall be designed in consultation with Central
5 Oklahoma Habitat for Humanity;

6 31. Family Career and Community Leaders of America Incorporated
7 License Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to persons
8 wishing to demonstrate support for Family Career and Community
9 Leaders of America Incorporated. The license plates shall be
10 designed in consultation with Family Career and Community Leaders of
11 America Incorporated;

12 32. Delta Sigma Theta License Plate - such plates shall be
13 designed and issued to any person who is a member of Delta Sigma
14 Theta Sorority. The license plates shall be designed in
15 consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority
16 Incorporated;

17 33. Omega Psi Phi License Plate - such plates shall be designed
18 and issued to any person who is a member of Omega Psi Phi
19 Fraternity. The license plates shall be designed in consultation
20 with the Oklahoma Chapter of Omega Psi Phi Fraternity Incorporated;

21 34. Alpha Phi Alpha License Plate - such plates shall be
22 designed and issued to any person who is a member of Alpha Phi Alpha
23 Fraternity. The license plates shall be designed in consultation
24

1 with the Oklahoma Chapter of Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity
2 Incorporated;

3 35. 50th Anniversary of the Interstate System of Highways
4 License Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to persons
5 wishing to commemorate the 50th Anniversary of the Interstate System
6 of Highways. The license plates shall be designed in consultation
7 with the American Association of State Highway and Transportation
8 Officials;

9 36. Kappa Alpha Psi License Plate - such plates shall be
10 designed and issued to any person who is a member of Kappa Alpha Psi
11 Fraternity. The license plates shall be designed in consultation
12 with the Oklahoma Chapter of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity
13 Incorporated;

14 37. Sigma Gamma Rho License Plate - such plates shall be
15 designed and issued to any person who is a member of Sigma Gamma Rho
16 Sorority. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with
17 the Oklahoma Chapter of Sigma Gamma Rho Sorority Incorporated.
18 Subject to the provisions of subsection A of this section, the Sigma
19 Gamma Rho License Plate is hereby reauthorized effective November 1,
20 2013;

21 38. Multiple Sclerosis License Plate - such plates shall be
22 designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
23 and increase awareness of multiple sclerosis. The license plates
24

1 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter of the
2 National Multiple Sclerosis Society;

3 39. Frederick Douglass High School License Plates - such plates
4 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
5 support for Frederick Douglass High School located in Oklahoma City.
6 The plates shall be designed in consultation with representatives of
7 Frederick Douglass High School National Alumni Association;

8 40. United States Air Force Academy License Plates - such
9 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
10 demonstrate support for the United States Air Force Academy;

11 41. In God We Trust License Plate - such plates shall be
12 designed to include the motto, "In God We Trust", and shall be
13 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the motto;

14 42. National Weather Center License Plate - such plates shall
15 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
16 for the National Weather Center in Norman. The plates shall be
17 designed in consultation with representatives of the National
18 Weather Center Directors;

19 43. Make-A-Wish Foundation License Plate - such plates shall be
20 designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
21 the Make-A-Wish Foundation. The license plates shall be designed in
22 consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter of the National Make-A-Wish
23 Foundation;

24

1 44. South Central Section PGA Foundation License Plate - such
2 plates shall be designed and issued to persons wishing to
3 demonstrate support for the South Central Section PGA Foundation.
4 The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the South
5 Central Section PGA Foundation;

6 45. Putnam City High School License Plate - such plates shall
7 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
8 for Putnam City High School. The plates shall be designed in
9 consultation with representatives of Putnam City High School Alumni
10 Association, Inc.;

11 46. Autism Awareness License Plate - such plates shall be
12 designed and issued to any person wishing to increase awareness of
13 autism. The license plate shall be designed in consultation with
14 the Oklahoma Autism Network;

15 47. Oklahoma Blood Institute License Plate - such plates shall
16 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
17 for the Oklahoma Blood Institute. The license plates shall be
18 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Blood Institute;

19 48. Zeta Phi Beta and Phi Beta Sigma License Plate - such
20 plates shall be designed and issued to any person who is a member of
21 Zeta Phi Beta Sorority or Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity. The license
22 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma chapters
23 of Zeta Phi Beta Sorority Incorporated and Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity
24 Incorporated;

1 49. Star Spencer High School License Plate - such plates shall
2 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
3 for Star Spencer High School located in Oklahoma City. The plates
4 shall be designed in consultation with representatives of the Star
5 Spencer High School Alumni Association;

6 50. Northeast High School License Plate - such plates shall be
7 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
8 Northeast High School located in Oklahoma City. The plates shall be
9 designed in consultation with representatives of the Northeast High
10 School Alumni Association;

11 51. Oklahoma City Central High School License Plate - such
12 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
13 demonstrate support for the Oklahoma City Central High School Alumni
14 Association. The plates shall be designed in consultation with
15 representatives of the Oklahoma City Central High School Alumni
16 Association;

17 52. Historic Greenwood District License Plate - such plates
18 shall be issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for music
19 festivals held in the Historic Greenwood District in Tulsa,
20 Oklahoma. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with
21 the Greenwood Cultural Center;

22 53. Oklahoma Rifle Association License Plate - such plates
23 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
24 support for the Oklahoma Rifle Association. The plates shall be

1 designed in consultation with representatives of the Oklahoma Rifle
2 Association;

3 54. Oklahoma City Thunder License Plate - such plates shall be
4 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
5 the Oklahoma City Thunder. The license plate shall be designed in
6 consultation with the Oklahoma City Thunder organization;

7 55. Ovarian Cancer Awareness License Plate - such plates shall
8 be designed and issued to any person wishing to increase awareness
9 of ovarian cancer. The license plate shall be designed in
10 consultation with the HOPE in Oklahoma organization;

11 56. BMW Car Club of America License Plate - such plates shall
12 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
13 for the BMW Car Club of America. The plates shall be issued to any
14 person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a
15 maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. The license
16 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Sunbelt Chapter of
17 the BMW Car Club of America. Subject to the provisions of
18 subsection A of this section, the BMW Car Club of America License
19 Plate is hereby reauthorized effective November 1, 2013;

20 57. Don't Tread On Me License Plate - such plates shall be
21 designed to include the yellow background and rattlesnake emblem
22 above the motto "DON'T TREAD ON ME" as found on the historic Gadsden
23 flag, and shall be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
24 support for the freedom and liberty of the Republic;

1 58. Oklahomans for the Arts License Plate - such plates shall
2 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
3 for arts, culture and creative industries as well as arts education.
4 The plates shall be designed in consultation with Oklahomans for the
5 Arts;

6 59. Oklahoma City Barons License Plate - such plates shall be
7 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
8 the Oklahoma City Barons. The license plate shall be designed in
9 consultation with the Oklahoma City Barons organization. The
10 license plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of
11 numbers and letters from one to a maximum of six;

12 60. Oklahoma City Redhawks License Plate - such plates shall be
13 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
14 the Oklahoma City Redhawks. The license plate shall be designed in
15 consultation with the Oklahoma City Redhawks organization;

16 61. Tulsa Shock License Plate - such plates shall be designed
17 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the
18 Tulsa Shock. The license plate shall be designed in consultation
19 with the Tulsa Shock organization;

20 62. Tulsa Oilers License Plate - such plates shall be designed
21 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the
22 Tulsa Oilers. The license plate shall be designed in consultation
23 with the Tulsa Oilers organization;

24

1 63. Tulsa Drillers License Plate - such plates shall be
2 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
3 the Tulsa Drillers. The license plate shall be designed in
4 consultation with the Tulsa Drillers organization;

5 64. Millwood School District License Plate - such plates shall
6 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
7 for the Millwood School District. The license plate shall be
8 designed in consultation with representatives of the Millwood School
9 District;

10 65. Booker T. Washington High School License Plate - such
11 plates shall be issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
12 Booker T. Washington High School and shall be designed in
13 consultation with the Booker T. Washington High School National
14 Alumni Association;

15 66. Oklahoma Current State Flag License Plate - such plates
16 shall be designed to include the current Oklahoma state flag and
17 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the current
18 Oklahoma state flag. The plates shall be designed in consultation
19 with the Friends of the Oklahoma History Center;

20 67. Oklahoma Original State Flag License Plate - such plates
21 shall be designed to include the original Oklahoma state flag and
22 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the original
23 Oklahoma state flag. The plates shall be designed in consultation
24 with the Friends of the Oklahoma History Center;

1 68. Tulsa 66ers License Plate - such plates shall be designed
2 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the
3 Tulsa 66ers. The plates shall be designed in consultation with the
4 Tulsa 66ers Organization; ~~and~~

5 69. Frederick Bombers License Plate - such plates shall be
6 issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the Frederick
7 School District and shall be designed in consultation with
8 representatives of the Frederick School District;

9 70. Childhood Cancer Awareness License Plate - such plates
10 shall be issued to any person wishing to increase awareness of
11 childhood cancer; and

12 71. 911 Dispatcher License Plate - such plates shall be issued
13 to persons wishing to demonstrate support for 911 dispatchers.
14 Persons applying for such license plate must show proof of current
15 employment as a 911 dispatcher or sign an attestation that they are
16 a currently employed or retired 911 dispatcher.

17 C. The fee for such plates shall be Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00)
18 and shall be in addition to all other registration fees provided by
19 the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. Unless otherwise
20 provided in this section, the fee shall be apportioned as follows:
21 Eight Dollars (\$8.00) of the special license plate fee shall be
22 deposited in the Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be
23 used for the administration of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and
24 Registration Act and the remaining Seven Dollars (\$7.00) of the

1 special license plate fee shall be apportioned as provided in
2 Section 1104 of this title.

3 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.5, as
4 last amended by Section 3, Chapter 372, O.S.L. 2014 (47 O.S. Supp.
5 2014, Section 1135.5), is amended to read as follows:

6 Section 1135.5 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
7 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license
8 plates to persons wishing to demonstrate support and provide
9 financial assistance as provided by this section.

10 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
11 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
12 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
13 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
14 registered for the current year with a motor license agent.

15 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax
16 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall
17 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates.
18 The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain
19 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor
20 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be
21 issued on a staggered system.

22 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
23 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept
24 applications for special license plates authorized under this

1 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's
2 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount
3 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
4 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
5 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents
6 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for
7 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for
8 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
9 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

10 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates
11 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1,
12 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of
13 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special
14 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license
15 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration
16 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be
17 removed from the vehicle.

18 For special license plates authorized on or after July 1, 2004,
19 no special license plates shall be developed or issued by the Tax
20 Commission until the Commission receives one hundred prepaid
21 applications therefor. The prepaid applications must be received by
22 the Tax Commission within one hundred eighty (180) days of the
23 effective date of the authorization or the authority to issue shall
24 be null and void. In the event one hundred prepaid applications are

1 not received by the Tax Commission within such prescribed time
2 period any payment so received shall be refunded accordingly.

3 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as
4 follows:

5 1. University or College Supporter License Plates - such plates
6 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
7 support to any state-supported or private university or college. As
8 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
9 apportioned as provided in Section 1104.1 of this title;

10 2. Environmental Awareness License Plates - such plates shall
11 be designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
12 Commission by the Department of Environmental Quality in
13 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any
14 person wishing to demonstrate support to implement the statewide
15 general public environmental education program created pursuant to
16 the provisions of the Oklahoma Environmental Quality Code. Such
17 plates shall be designed and issued to any person in any combination
18 of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for
19 personalized license plates. A dealer's license plate issued
20 pursuant to Section 1116.1 or 1128 of this title may be designated
21 an Environmental Awareness License Plate upon payment of the fee
22 imposed by this section and any other registration fees required by
23 the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. As provided in
24

1 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned
2 pursuant to Section 1104.2 of this title;

3 3. Firefighter License Plates - such plates shall be designed
4 for any career or retired firefighter, volunteer or paid.

5 Firefighters may apply for firefighter plates for up to four
6 vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a
7 motorcycle upon proof of a fire department membership by either an
8 identification card or letter from the chief of the fire department.
9 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
10 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to
11 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any
12 deceased firefighter, if the spouse has not since remarried, may
13 apply for a firefighter license plate for one vehicle with a rated
14 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon
15 proof that the deceased firefighter was a member of a fire
16 department by either an identification card or letter from the chief
17 of the fire department.

18 Except for motorcycles, the license plate shall have the legend
19 "Oklahoma" in the color Pantone 186C Red and shall contain no more
20 than three letters and three numbers in the color Pantone 301C Blue.
21 Between the letters and numbers shall be the Firefighter Maltese
22 Cross Logo in the color Pantone 186C Red outlined in the color
23 Pantone 301C Blue. Below the letters and the logo shall be the word
24 "Firefighter" in the color Pantone 186C Red. The license plate for

1 motorcycles may be of a similar design as space permits or a new
2 design in order to meet the space requirements of a motorcycle
3 license plate. The plates shall not be subject to the design
4 requirements of any other license plates prescribed by law other
5 than the space for the placement of the yearly decals for each
6 succeeding year of registration after the initial issue.

7 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
8 shall be deposited to the Oklahoma State Firemen's Museum Building &
9 Memorial Fund for support of the Oklahoma Firefighter Fallen and
10 Living Memorial;

11 4. Wildlife Conservation License Plates - such plates shall be
12 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
13 Commission by the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation in
14 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any
15 person wishing to demonstrate support for wildlife conservation in
16 this state through the Wildlife Diversity Fund, provided for in
17 Section 3-310 of Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Such plates may
18 be designed and issued to any person as for personalized license
19 plates.

20 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
21 shall be apportioned pursuant to subsection D of Section 3-310 of
22 Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

23 5. Child Abuse Prevention License Plates - such plates shall be
24 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax

1 Commission by the Office of Child Abuse Prevention in the State
2 Department of Health and the Oklahoma Committee to Prevent Child
3 Abuse, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
4 the prevention of child abuse.

5 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
6 shall be deposited in the Child Abuse Prevention Fund;

7 6. United States Olympic Committee Supporter License Plates -
8 such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
9 demonstrate support for the United States Olympic Committee. The
10 plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers
11 and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized
12 license plates. The plate shall contain the official United States
13 Olympic Committee logo. The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if
14 necessary, to enter into a licensing agreement with the United
15 States Olympic Committee for any licensing fees which may be
16 required in order to use the United States Olympic Committee logo or
17 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment of not
18 more than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for each license plate
19 issued;

20 7. Oklahoma History License Plates - such plates shall be
21 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate interest in
22 Oklahoma history. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
23 collected shall be deposited to the Oklahoma Historical Society
24 Revolving Fund to be used for educational purposes;

1 8. Historic Route 66 License Plates - such plates shall be
2 designed to honor historic Route 66, also known as the "Mother
3 Road". As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
4 shall be apportioned to the Oklahoma Historical Society Revolving
5 Fund to be distributed to the Route 66 Museum located in Clinton,
6 Oklahoma;

7 9. Heart of the Heartland License Plates - such plates shall be
8 designed and issued to any person wishing to honor the victims of
9 the terrorist bombing attack on the Alfred P. Murrah Federal
10 Building in downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995. As provided
11 in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited
12 in the Heart of the Heartland Scholarship Fund, as established in
13 Section 2282 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

14 10. Emergency Medical Technician License Plates - such plates
15 shall be designed and issued to any person who is an emergency
16 medical technician. Such persons may apply for an emergency medical
17 technician license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
18 capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of an emergency medical
19 technician's license. The license plate shall be designed in
20 consultation with the state association of emergency medical
21 technicians. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
22 collected shall be apportioned to the Emergency Medical Technician
23 Death Benefit Revolving Fund created in Section 1-2505.2 of Title 63
24 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

1 11. Fight Breast Cancer License Plates - such plates shall be
2 designed to demonstrate support for the prevention and treatment of
3 breast cancer in this state. As provided in this section, an amount
4 of the fee collected shall be apportioned to the Breast Cancer Act
5 Revolving Fund;

6 12. Crime Victims Awareness License Plates - such plates shall
7 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
8 awareness of and support for victims of crimes. The license plates
9 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Crime Victims
10 Centre. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
11 shall be apportioned to the Attorney General's Revolving Fund for
12 the Office of the Attorney General, which is hereby directed to use
13 such funds to contract with a statewide nonprofit organization to
14 provide services to crime victims;

15 13. Oklahoma Safe Kids Association License Plates - such plates
16 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
17 support and awareness of the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association. The
18 license plate shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
19 Safe Kids Association. As provided in this section, an amount of
20 the fee collected shall be deposited in the Children's Hospital -
21 Oklahoma Safe Kids Association Revolving Fund to be distributed to
22 the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association program;

23 14. Four-H Club License Plates - such plates shall be designed,
24 subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission by the

1 Four-H Foundation, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
2 support of the Four-H Club. Such plates may be designed and issued
3 to any person as for personalized license plates. As provided in
4 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned to
5 the OSU Extension Service License Plate Revolving Fund created in
6 Section 1104.4 of this title;

7 15. Agricultural Awareness License Plates - such plates shall
8 be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax
9 Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and
10 Forestry in consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued
11 to any person wishing to demonstrate support of the Department's Ag
12 in the Classroom Education Program. As provided in this section, an
13 amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in
14 Section 1104.3 of this title;

15 16. Oklahoma Statehood Centennial License Plates - such plates
16 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to commemorate
17 the centennial of Oklahoma's admission to statehood in 1907. The
18 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
19 Capitol Complex and Centennial Commemoration Commission. As
20 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
21 deposited in the Oklahoma Capitol Complex and Centennial
22 Commemoration Commission Revolving Fund created in Section 98.5 of
23 Title 73 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

24

1 17. Support Education License Plates - such plates shall be
2 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
3 by the State Department of Education in consultation with the
4 Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any person wishing to
5 demonstrate support for education in this state. All motor license
6 agents shall display a sample of the Support Education License plate
7 in the area of the business accessed by the public. Twenty-three
8 Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee collected shall be apportioned as
9 follows:

- 10 a. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Education
11 Reform Revolving Fund,
- 12 b. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Higher
13 Education Revolving Fund,
- 14 c. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the State
15 Career Technology Fund, and
- 16 d. eighty-five percent (85%) of the fee shall be
17 deposited to the Teachers' Retirement Benefit Fund as
18 set forth in Section 17-108 of Title 70 of the
19 Oklahoma Statutes.

20 However, when the Teachers' Retirement Benefit Fund attains a
21 seventy percent (70%) funded ratio based on an annual actuarial
22 valuation as required by law, the amount of the fee shall be
23 apportioned equally pursuant to subparagraphs a, b and c of this
24 paragraph;

1 18. Retired Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers License Plates -
2 such plates shall be designed and issued to any retired officer of
3 the Oklahoma Highway Patrol. The license plate shall have the
4 legend "Oklahoma" and shall contain, in the center of the plate, the
5 Highway Patrol Officers patch using the same colors and pattern as
6 used in the patch. Centered on the bottom of the license plate
7 shall be the word "Retired". The letters "TRP" shall be used in
8 combination with three numbers on either side of the insignia or
9 emblem. The color of the letters and numbers shall be brown.
10 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
11 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to
12 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any
13 deceased retired officer of the Oklahoma Highway Patrol, if the
14 spouse has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is
15 terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a Retired
16 Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers license plate. As provided in this
17 section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited into the
18 Law Enforcement Retirement Fund;

19 19. Boy Scouts of America Supporter License Plates - such
20 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
21 demonstrate support for the Boy Scouts of America. The plates shall
22 be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters
23 from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates.
24 The plate shall contain the official Boy Scouts of America logo.

1 The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into
2 a licensing agreement with the Boy Scouts of America for any
3 licensing fees which may be required in order to use the Boy Scouts
4 of America logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide
5 for a payment to the Boy Scouts of America of not more than Twenty
6 Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

7 20. Urban Forestry and Beautification License Plates - such
8 plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the
9 Tax Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and
10 Forestry in consultation with nonprofit organizations in this state
11 that develop and operate programs to encourage urban forestry and
12 beautification, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
13 support of such programs. As provided in this section, an amount of
14 the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in Section 1104.5
15 of this title;

16 21. Oklahoma State Parks Supporter License Plates - such plates
17 shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax
18 Commission by the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department, and
19 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma
20 state parks system. Twenty-three Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee
21 collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation
22 Department Revolving Fund. Such money shall be designated for and
23 may only be expended for the support of Oklahoma state parks;

24

1 22. Adoption Creates Families License Plates - such plates
2 shall be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support of
3 pregnant women who are committed to placing their children for
4 adoption and wishing to provide assistance to guardians, adoptive
5 parents and other created families to assist in the adoption and
6 placement of children in permanent, safe homes. The license plates
7 shall be designed and final terminology delivered in consultation
8 with the Oklahoma Adoption Coalition and the Department of Human
9 Services. Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee collected shall
10 be deposited in a revolving fund established in the State Treasury
11 for and to be used by the Department of Human Services for the
12 implementation of the Investing in Stronger Oklahoma Families Act
13 specifically for created families;

14 23. Choose Life License Plates - such plates shall be designed,
15 subject to criteria presented to the Tax Commission, by Choose Life,
16 Inc., and issued to any person who wishes to demonstrate support of
17 organizations that encourage adoption as a positive choice for women
18 with unplanned pregnancies. As provided in this section, an amount
19 of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Choose Life
20 Assistance Program Revolving Fund established in Section 1104.6 of
21 this title;

22 24. Future Farmers of America License Plate - such plates shall
23 be designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
24 the Oklahoma FFA (formerly known as Future Farmers of America). The

1 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
2 FFA Foundation Board of Directors. As provided in this section, an
3 amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in
4 Section 1104.7 of this title;

5 25. Lions Club License Plates - such plates shall be designed
6 and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the Lions
7 Club of Oklahoma. The plates shall be issued to any person in any
8 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven,
9 as for personalized license plates. The license plates shall be
10 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation
11 and shall contain the official logo of the International Association
12 of Lions Clubs. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter
13 into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma Lions Service
14 Foundation. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to
15 the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation of not more than Ten Dollars
16 (\$10.00) for each license plate issued;

17 26. Color Oklahoma License Plates - such plates shall be
18 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
19 by the Oklahoma Native Plant Society, and issued to any person
20 wishing to demonstrate support for preserving and planting
21 wildflowers and native plants in Oklahoma and to promote Oklahoma's
22 wildflower heritage through education. As provided in this section,
23 an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in
24 Section 1104.8 of this title;

1 27. Girl Scouts of the United States of America Supporter
2 License Plates - such plates shall be designed and issued to any
3 person wishing to demonstrate support for the Girl Scouts of the
4 United States of America. The plates shall be issued to any person
5 in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of
6 seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate shall contain
7 the official Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo. The
8 Tax Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into a
9 licensing agreement with the Girl Scouts of the United States of
10 America for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use
11 the Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo or design. The
12 licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Girl Scouts
13 of Magic Empire Council, acting on behalf of all Oklahoma Girl Scout
14 councils, of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
15 plate issued;

16 28. Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon License Plates - such
17 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
18 demonstrate support for the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon. The
19 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma City
20 Memorial Marathon. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter
21 into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon
22 for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the
23 Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon logo or design. The licensing
24 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Oklahoma City Memorial

1 Marathon of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
2 plate issued;

3 29. Oklahoma Scenic Rivers License Plate - such plates shall be
4 designed to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma Scenic Rivers. The
5 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Scenic
6 Rivers Commission. Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee shall be
7 apportioned to the Oklahoma Scenic Rivers Commission;

8 30. Fight Cancer License Plate - such plates shall be designed
9 to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma Central Cancer Registry.
10 The plate shall contain the American Cancer Society logo. The
11 American Cancer Society logo shall be used in accordance with the
12 American Cancer Society's branding guidelines and shall only be
13 utilized to support the Oklahoma Central Cancer Registry. Twenty
14 Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee shall be apportioned to the Oklahoma
15 Central Cancer Registry Revolving Fund;

16 31. Animal Friendly License Plate - such plates shall be
17 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
18 controlling the overpopulation of dogs and cats through educational
19 and sterilization efforts. The plates shall be designed in
20 consultation with the Veterinary Medical Association. Twenty
21 Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee collected shall be designated by the
22 purchaser of the plate to be deposited in the Oklahoma Pet
23 Overpopulation Fund created in Section 2368.13 of Title 68 of the
24

1 Oklahoma Statutes or the Animal Friendly Revolving Fund created in
2 Section 1104.10 of this title;

3 32. Patriot License Plate - such plates shall be designed in
4 consultation with the Military Department of Oklahoma and issued to
5 any person wishing to demonstrate support for Oklahoma residents who
6 are members of the Oklahoma National Guard and deployed on active
7 duty. The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination
8 of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for
9 personalized license plates. As provided in this section, a portion
10 of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Patriot License Plate
11 Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.11 of this title;

12 33. Global War on Terrorism License Plate - such plate shall be
13 designed in consultation with the Military Department of Oklahoma
14 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for Oklahoma
15 residents who are members of the Armed Forces of the United States
16 or Oklahoma National Guard that have served in the Global War on
17 Terrorism. The plate shall be issued to any person in any
18 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of six. As
19 provided in this section, a portion of the fee collected shall be
20 deposited in the 45th Infantry Division Museum Fund created in
21 Section 235.1 of Title 44 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

22 34. Boys and Girls Clubs of America Supporter License Plates -
23 such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
24 demonstrate support for the Boys and Girls Clubs of America. The

1 plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers
2 and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized
3 license plates. The plate shall contain the official Boys and Girls
4 Clubs of America logo. The Tax Commission, if necessary, may enter
5 into a licensing agreement with the Boys and Girls Clubs of America
6 for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the
7 Boys and Girls Clubs of America logo or design. The licensing
8 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Boys and Girls Clubs of
9 America of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
10 plate issued;

11 35. Oklahoma Quarter Horse License Plates - such plates shall
12 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
13 for the American Quarter Horse in Oklahoma. The plate shall be
14 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Quarter Horse
15 Association. As provided in this section, a portion of the fee
16 collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Quarter Horse Revolving
17 Fund created in Section 1104.12 of this title;

18 36. Oklahoma Association for the Deaf License Plate - such
19 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
20 Association for the Deaf and issued to any person wishing to
21 demonstrate support for Oklahoma residents who are deaf. The plates
22 shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and
23 letters from one to maximum of seven, as for personalized license
24 plates. As provided in this section, a portion of the fee collected

1 shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Association for the Deaf License
2 Plate Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.15 of this title;

3 37. Oklahoma City Zoo License Plate - such plates shall be
4 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma
5 City Zoo. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with
6 the Oklahoma Zoological Society, Inc. As provided in this section,
7 an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma
8 Zoological Society Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.13 of this
9 title;

10 38. March of Dimes License Plate - such plates shall be issued
11 to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the March of Dimes
12 mission to improve the health of babies by preventing birth defects,
13 premature birth and infant mortality. The license plates shall be
14 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter March of Dimes.
15 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
16 deposited in the Oklahoma Prevent Birth Defects, Premature Birth and
17 Infant Mortality Fund established in Section 1104.14 of this title;

18 39. Support Our Troops Supporter License Plates - such plates
19 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
20 support for Support Our Troops Incorporated. The plates shall be
21 issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from
22 one to a maximum of six. The plate shall contain the official
23 Support Our Troops Incorporated logo which includes the mark
24 "Support Our Troops" across the bottom of the plate. The Tax

1 Commission, if necessary, may enter into a licensing agreement with
2 Support Our Troops Incorporated for any licensing fees which may be
3 required in order to use the Support Our Troops Incorporated logo or
4 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to
5 Support Our Troops Incorporated of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for
6 each license plate issued;

7 40. Folds of Honor Supporter License Plate - such plates shall
8 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
9 for Folds of Honor Incorporated, a nonprofit charitable organization
10 exempt from taxation pursuant to the provisions of the Internal
11 Revenue Code, 26 U.S.C., Section 501(c)(3), providing academic and
12 vocational training scholarships to dependents of military
13 servicemen and servicewomen who were either killed or wounded in
14 action due to military service in the war in Iraq or Afghanistan.
15 The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of
16 numbers and letters from one to a maximum of six. The plate shall
17 be designed in consultation with Folds of Honor Incorporated and
18 shall contain the official Folds of Honor Incorporated logo which
19 includes the mark "Folds of Honor" across the bottom of the plate.
20 The Tax Commission, if necessary, may enter into a licensing
21 agreement with Folds of Honor Incorporated for any licensing fees
22 which may be required in order to use the Folds of Honor
23 Incorporated logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide
24

1 for a payment to Folds of Honor Incorporated of Twenty-five Dollars
2 (\$25.00) for each license plate issued;

3 41. Downed Bikers Association License Plate - such plates shall
4 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
5 for the Downed Bikers Association, a nonprofit charitable
6 organization exempt from taxation pursuant to the provisions of the
7 Internal Revenue Code, 26 U.S.C., Section 501(c)(3), which provides
8 emotional and financial support for downed bikers. The license
9 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Central Oklahoma
10 Chapter of the Downed Bikers Association and shall contain any
11 official logo or design of the organization. The Tax Commission, if
12 necessary, may enter into a licensing agreement with the Downed
13 Bikers Association for any licensing fees which may be required in
14 order to use the organization's logo or design. The licensing
15 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Downed Bikers
16 Association of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each
17 license plate;

18 42. Armed Forces Veterans Motorcycle License Plate - such
19 plates shall be designed for use on a motorcycle in consultation
20 with A Brotherhood Aiming Toward Education of Oklahoma, Inc.
21 (ABATE), and issued to any honorably discharged former member of the
22 United States Armed Forces wishing to demonstrate support for the
23 45th Infantry Division Museum. Persons applying for such license
24 plate must show proof of past military service. As provided in this

1 section, a portion of the fee collected shall be deposited in the
2 45th Infantry Division Museum Fund created in Section 235.1 of Title
3 44 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

4 43. Buffalo Soldier License Plate - such plates shall be issued
5 to any person wishing to honor and celebrate the history and
6 contribution of the Buffalo Soldiers. The license plates shall be
7 designed in consultation with the Lawton-Fort Sill Chapter of the
8 Buffalo Soldiers 9th and 10th (Horse) Cavalry Association. As
9 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
10 deposited in the Buffalo Soldier License Plate Revolving Fund
11 created in Section 1104.16 of this title;

12 44. Prevent Blindness Oklahoma License Plate - such plates
13 shall be issued to any person wishing to provide financial support
14 for vision screening of school age children in this state. The
15 license plates shall be designed in consultation with Prevent
16 Blindness Oklahoma. As provided in this section, an amount of the
17 fee collected shall be deposited in the Prevent Blindness Oklahoma
18 License Plate Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.17 of this
19 title;

20 45. Oklahoma State Capitol Restoration License Plate - such
21 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
22 demonstrate support for restoration of the Oklahoma State Capitol
23 building. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with
24 the Friends of the Capitol corporation, created pursuant to Section

1 15.4 of Title 73 of the Oklahoma Statutes and the State Capitol
2 Preservation Commission created pursuant to Section 4102 of Title 74
3 of the Oklahoma Statutes. As provided in this section, an amount of
4 the fee collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Friends of the
5 Capitol License Plate Revolving Fund established in Section 1104.18
6 of this title;

7 46. Eastern Red Cedar Tree License Plates - such plates shall
8 be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax
9 Commission and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
10 for the removal of Eastern Red Cedar trees from lands in the state
11 and to develop marketable uses for the harvested trees. The license
12 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Eastern Red Cedar
13 Registry Board. Twenty-three Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee collected
14 shall be deposited in the Eastern Red Cedar Revolving Fund created
15 in Section 18-407 of Title 2 of the Oklahoma Statutes. The money
16 shall be designated for and may only be expended for the purposes as
17 set forth in the Eastern Red Cedar Registry Board Act;

18 47. Pancreatic Cancer Research License Plate - such plates
19 shall be issued to any person wishing to provide financial support
20 for the University of Oklahoma Foundation, Pancreatic Cancer
21 Research Fund. The plates shall be issued to any person in any
22 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of six.
23 The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the
24 University of Oklahoma Foundation, Pancreatic Cancer Research Fund.

1 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
2 deposited in the Pancreatic Cancer Research License Plate Revolving
3 Fund created in Section 1104.19 of this title;

4 48. Alzheimer's Research License Plate - such plates shall be
5 issued to any person wishing to provide financial support for the
6 Oklahoma Chapter of the Alzheimer's Association. The license plates
7 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter of the
8 Alzheimer's Association. As provided in this section, an amount of
9 the fee collected shall be deposited in the Alzheimer's Research
10 License Plate Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.20 of this
11 title;

12 49. Hospice and Palliative Care License Plate - such plates
13 shall be issued to any person wishing to provide financial support
14 for the Oklahoma Hospice and Palliative Care Association. The
15 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
16 Hospice and Palliative Care Association. As provided in this
17 section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in the
18 Hospice and Palliative Care License Plate Revolving Fund created in
19 Section 1104.21 of this title;

20 50. Juvenile Diabetes Research License Plate - such plates
21 shall be issued to any person wishing to provide financial support
22 for the Oklahoma Chapters of the Juvenile Diabetes Research
23 Foundation. The license plates shall be designed in consultation
24 with the Oklahoma Chapters of the Juvenile Diabetes Research

1 Foundation. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
2 collected shall be deposited in the Juvenile Diabetes Research
3 License Plate Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.22 of this
4 title;

5 51. Deer Creek Schools Foundation License Plate - such plates
6 shall be issued to any person wishing to provide financial support
7 for the Deer Creek Schools Foundation. The license plates shall be
8 designed in consultation with the Deer Creek Schools Foundation. As
9 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
10 deposited in the Deer Creek Schools Foundation License Plate
11 Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.23 of this title;

12 52. Lupus Awareness and Education License Plate - such plates
13 shall be issued to any person wishing to provide financial support
14 for the Lupus Foundation of Oklahoma. The license plates shall be
15 designed in consultation with the Lupus Foundation of Oklahoma. As
16 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
17 deposited in the Oklahoma Lupus License Plate Revolving Fund created
18 in Section 1104.24 of this title;

19 53. Chiefs of Police License Plate - such plates shall be
20 issued to any person wishing to provide financial support for the
21 Oklahoma Association of Chiefs of Police. The license plates shall
22 be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Association of Chiefs
23 of Police. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
24 collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Association of Chiefs

1 of Police License Plate Revolving Fund created in Section 1 of this
2 act;

3 54. Crossings Christian School License Plate - such plates
4 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
5 support for Crossings Christian School located in Oklahoma City.
6 The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the
7 administration of Crossings Christian School. The Tax Commission
8 shall be authorized to enter into a licensing agreement with
9 Crossings Christian School for any licensing fees which may be
10 required in order to use the school's logo or design. The licensing
11 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Crossings Christian
12 School of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
13 plate issued; ~~and~~

14 55. Oklahoma Nurses License Plate - such plates shall be issued
15 to any person licensed pursuant to the Oklahoma Nursing Practice Act
16 and providing such documentation of current licensure as may be
17 required by the Oklahoma Tax Commission. The license plates shall
18 be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Nurses Association.
19 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
20 deposited in the Oklahoma Nurses License Plate Revolving Fund
21 created in Section 4 1104.26 of this ~~act~~ title; and

22 56. Oklahoma Sports Hall of Fame License Plate - such plates
23 shall be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the
24 Oklahoma Sports Hall of Fame. The license plates shall be designed

1 in consultation with the administration of the Oklahoma Sports Hall
2 of Fame. The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter
3 into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma Sports Hall of Fame for
4 any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the Hall of
5 Fame's logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a
6 payment to the Oklahoma Sports Hall of Fame of not more than Twenty
7 Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued.

8 C. The fee for such plates shall be Thirty-five Dollars
9 (\$35.00) and shall be in addition to all other registration fees
10 provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. The
11 fee shall be apportioned as follows:

12 1. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) or any other amount as provided in
13 this title of the fee shall be apportioned as provided or deposited
14 in a fund as specified within the paragraph authorizing the special
15 license plate;

16 2. Eight Dollars (\$8.00) of the fee shall be deposited in the
17 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be used for the
18 administration of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act;
19 and

20 3. Any remaining amounts of the fee shall be apportioned as
21 provided in Section 1104 of this title.

22 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.
