## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, in firearms and other dangerous
- articles, providing for duty to report lost or stolen weapon.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 § 6111.6. Duty to report lost or stolen weapon.
- 9 (a) Duty to designate. -- A school entity and institution of
- 10 <u>higher education shall designate a person or persons to whom a</u>
- 11 lost or stolen weapon is to be reported as required by
- 12 <u>subsection (b).</u>
- (b) Duty to report. -- If a weapon that the parent or guardian
- 14 owns, possesses or has custody or control over is lost or
- 15 stolen, the parent, quardian or other person having control or
- 16 charge of a student who is enrolled in a school entity or
- 17 institution of higher education shall report the loss or theft
- 18 to:

- 1 (1) a person designated under subsection (a) at the
- 2 school entity or institution of higher education in which the
- 3 student is enrolled; and
- 4 (2) the municipal police force or, if the municipality
- 5 <u>does not have a police force, the Pennsylvania State Police.</u>
- 6 (c) Liability. -- Notwithstanding the monetary limits of
- 7 <u>liability specified in 23 Pa.C.S. § 5505 (relating to monetary</u>
- 8 <u>limits of liability</u>), a parent, guardian or other person who has
- 9 <u>control or charge of a student and who fails to report as</u>
- 10 required by subsection (b) shall be liable, without monetary
- 11 limitation, for the injuries sustained by a person present at
- 12 the school entity or institution of higher education in which
- 13 the student is enrolled if the student or any other person
- 14 inflicted the injuries with the lost or stolen weapon.
- 15 (d) Applicability and presumption. -- The following apply:
- 16 (1) This section shall not apply to a parent, quardian
- or other person having control or charge of a student
- 18 enrolled at an institution of higher education where the
- 19 student is emancipated from the parent, quardian or other
- person.
- 21 (2) It shall be presumed that a student is emancipated
- from a parent if a court has issued an order or otherwise
- 23 determined that the parent is not responsible for the
- 24 postsecondary educational costs of the student under 23
- 25 <u>Pa.C.S. § 4327 (relating to postsecondary educational costs).</u>
- 26 (e) Regulations.--The Secretary of Education shall
- 27 promulgate regulations to carry out the provisions of this
- 28 section.
- 29 (f) Definitions.--As used in this section, the following
- 30 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this

- 1 <u>subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:</u>
- 2 <u>"Institution of higher education."</u> As defined under section
- 3 118 of the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the
- 4 Public School Code of 1949.
- 5 <u>"School entity." A public school district, intermediate</u>
- 6 <u>unit, area vocational-technical school, charter school, private</u>
- 7 <u>school or parochial school.</u>
- 8 "Weapon." As defined under section 1301-A of the Public
- 9 School Code of 1949.
- 10 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
