AN ACT

- Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in firearms and other dangerous 2 articles, further providing for limitation on the regulation of firearms and ammunition. 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 6 hereby enacts as follows: 7 Section 1. Section 6120(a.2), (a.3) and (b) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are reenacted and amended to read: § 6120. Limitation on the regulation of firearms and 10 11 ammunition. * * * 12 Relief. -- A person adversely affected by an ordinance, 13 a resolution, regulation, rule, practice or any other action

- promulgated or enforced by a county, municipality or township 15

- 1 prohibited under subsection (a) or 53 Pa.C.S. § 2962(g)
- 2 (relating to limitation on municipal powers) may seek
- 3 declaratory or injunctive relief and actual damages in an

- 5 (a.3) Reasonable expenses.--[A] <u>If a person adversely</u>
- 6 <u>affected provided 30 days' prior written notice of his intention</u>
- 7 to file an action pursuant to subsection (a.2) to the defendant,
- 8 the court shall award reasonable expenses to [a] the person
- 9 adversely affected in an action under subsection (a.2) for any
- 10 of the following:
- 11 (1) A final determination by the court is granted in
- 12 favor of the person adversely affected.
- 13 (2) The regulation in question is rescinded, repealed or
- otherwise abrogated after suit has been filed under
- 15 subsection (a.2) but before the final determination by the
- 16 court.
- 17 (b) Definitions.--As used in this section, the following
- 18 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 19 subsection:
- 20 "Dealer." The term shall include any person engaged in the
- 21 business of selling at wholesale or retail a firearm or
- 22 ammunition.
- 23 "Firearms." This term shall have the meaning given to it in
- 24 section 5515 (relating to prohibiting of paramilitary training)
- 25 but shall not include air rifles as that term is defined in
- 26 section 6304 (relating to sale and use of air rifles).
- 27 "Person adversely affected." Any of the following:
- 28 (1) A resident of this Commonwealth who may legally
- 29 possess a firearm under Federal and State law.
- 30 (2) A person who otherwise has standing under the laws

- of this Commonwealth to bring an action under subsection
- 2 (a.2).
- 3 (3) A membership organization, in which a member is a
- 4 person described under paragraph (1) or (2).
- 5 "Political subdivision." The term shall include any home
- 6 rule charter municipality, county, city, borough, incorporated
- 7 town, township or school district.
- 8 "Reasonable expenses." The term includes, but is not limited
- 9 to, attorney fees, expert witness fees, court costs and
- 10 compensation for loss of income.
- 11 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
