- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise certain restrictions relating to road hunting. 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA: 3 Section 1. That § 41-9-1.5 be amended to read as follows: 4 41-9-1.5. In order to protect the public safety, it is the intent of the Legislature that hunting 5 from highways or other public rights-of-way be accomplished without the use of motorized 6 vehicles. Therefore, the following restrictions apply to such hunting any person engaged in 7 hunting from a highway or public right-of-way: 8 No person hunting small game from any highway or other public right-of-way (1) 9 pursuant to § 41-9-1.1 may discharge a firearm at any small game animal unless the 10 motor vehicle by which the person has been transported to the hunting location has, 11 to the maximum extent practical, been parked, with the doors closed, off the main 12 traveled portion of the highway or public right-of-way in a manner that does not 13 create an unreasonable risk of injury or damage to other persons or property using the 14 highway or public right-of-way;
