1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to allow a concealed pistol in the capitol with an enhanced 2 concealed pistol permit. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA: 4 Section 1. That § 22-14-24 be amended to read: 5 22-14-24. The provisions of § 22-14-23 do not apply to: 6 (1) The lawful performance of official duties by an officer, agent, or employee of the United States, the state, political subdivision thereof, or a municipality, who is 8 authorized by law to engage in or supervise the prevention, detection, investigation, 9 or prosecution of any violation of law or an officer of the court; 10 (2) Possession The possession by a judge or magistrate; 11 (3) The possession of a firearm or other dangerous weapon by a federal or state official 12 or member of the armed services if such possession is authorized by law; or 13 The possession of a concealed pistol in the state capitol, other than in the chambers (4) 14 of the Supreme Court, by a person who was issued an enhanced permit pursuant to 15 § 23-7-53 and who has registered, at least twenty-four hours in advance, with capitol - 2 - HB 1156

1		security. The registration is valid for the length of time indicated by the permit
2		holder, not to exceed thirty days, at which time the permit holder may submit a new
3		registration. No fee may be charged for registering to carry;
4	<u>(5)</u>	The possession of a concealed pistol in the state capitol by a qualified law
5		enforcement officer or qualified retired law enforcement officer pursuant to the Law
6		Enforcement Officers Safety Act, 18 U.S.C. § 926B and § 926C; or
7	<u>(6)</u>	The lawful carrying of firearms, or other dangerous weapons in a county courthouse
8		incident to hunting, or gun safety course or to other lawful purposes.
