16	(a) A person shall not manufacture or export any product or item if under
17	the law of this State it is illegal to possess the product or item in Vermont.
18	(b) A person who violates this subsection shall be imprisoned not more
19	than one year or fined not more than \$1,000.00, or both.

3	(a) A person shall not manufacture, possess, transfer, offer for sale,

8	possessed the device on or before the effective date of this section.
