13	§ 4710. SAFETY ZONE; SHOOTING PROHIBITED
14	(a)(1) A person may on land owned or occupied by him or her and Except
15	as set forth in subdivision (2) of this subsection, no person may discharge a
16	firearm within 500 feet of any occupied dwelling house, residence, or other
17	building or camp occupied by human beings, or any barn, stable, or other
18	building used in connection therewith, maintain posters furnished by the
19	Department of Fish and Wildlife not less than 12 inches wide and 18 inches

1	high containing the words "safety zone, shooting prohibited." with occupied
2	buildings.
3	(2) The prohibition under subdivision (1) of this subsection shall not apply
4	<u>to:</u>
5	(A) a person discharging a firearm or taking wildlife on land that the
6	person owns or occupies or for which the person holds written permission to
7	discharge a firearm or take wildlife by the person who owns or controls the
8	land; or
9	(B) a State, federal, or municipal law enforcement officer or
10	employee when the law enforcement officer or employee is acting within the
11	course of the officer's or employee's employment.
12	(3) An area bounded by such posters placed at each corner, and not more
13	than 200 feet apart on the boundaries The land within 500 feet of an occupied
14	dwelling house, residence, or other building or camp occupied by human
15	beings or any barn, stable, or other building used in connection with an
16	occupied building shall be considered enclosed land for the purpose of this
17	section and is hereby defined as a "safety zone." Without advance permission
18	of the owner or occupant, a person shall not discharge a firearm within or take
19	a wild animal that is within a "safety zone" as defined herein.
