2	under W.S. $21-9-101$ and $21-9-102$ and the student content
3	and performance standards promulgated under paragraph
4	(a)(iii) of this section <u>., and</u> <u>The state board, in</u>
5	consultation with the state superintendent, shall establish
6	a process to receive input or concerns related to the
7	student content and performance standards from
8	stakeholders, including but not limited to parents,
9	teachers, school and district administrators and members of
10	the public at large, at any time prior to the formal review
11	by the state board. The state board shall report findings
12	and recommendations to the joint education interim
13	committee of the legislature on or before December 1 of the
14	year in which the <u>formal</u> review and evaluation <u>of the</u>
15	student content and performance standards was undertaken.
16	The joint education interim committee shall report its
17	recommendations, based upon findings and recommendations of
18	the state board, to the legislature during the immediately
19	following legislative session.

21	Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2015.
